

FROM THE DESK OF FATHER HERTGES

I wish to begin this week's bulletin column with some fabulous news that merits to be shared with all of you! Towards the end of last week I received a letter dated March 29, 2022 from the Iowa Department of Cultural Affairs.

The two-page document from aforementioned government entity located in Des Moines was mailed to St. Benedict Parish regarding *Broadway-Phelps Park Historic District (Boundary Increase) 307 West Main Street Decorah, Iowa.* Here I will quote the first two complete sentences for the sake of accuracy. "We are pleased to inform you that above-named Boundary Increase was listed on the National Register of Historic places effective March 14, 2022. The National Register is the Federal Government's official list of historic properties worthy of preservation. Listing in the National register provides recognition and assets in preserving our Nation's heritage."

Some of you may recall that in May of 2019 our parish received the Historic Preservation Award, and the plaque that proudly hangs in the church hall near the kitchen area has its origins in and through the local recognition of historic preservation of St. Benedict Church.

Therefore, the recently received recognition, and accompanying documents attesting to being placed on the National Register of Historic Places, is the happy culmination of the capital campaign's masterful addition and renovation of St. Benedict Church that was completed in 2018. Thus, the documents from the state of lowa are a fitting complement to the discernment, planning and execution of the addition and renovation that was in its final stages when I began this assignment in July of 2018.

Congratulations to our entire parish; especially those who had *any part* in the discernment/conception of the project in addition to all of you who have contributed to the capital campaign. I am all about preservation of historical buildings, places and documents; especially when they can continue to witness to past legacies and serve people in the present-day; meeting current realities and challenges. Our parish has risen to the occasion admirably in this regard; both prior to and during the pandemic!

Finally, while I am on the topic of rising to the occasion and history; Palm Sunday of course is the liturgical commencement of Holy Week. This is the week by which the Church commemorates the entrance of Christ the Lord into Jerusalem in order to fulfill the Paschal Mystery and the manifestation of God's plan of salvation for us.

Please note that there will *not be* Tuesday evening Mass followed by stations of the cross as I plan to travel to Dubuque to partake in the Chrism Mass at 2:00pm, whereby I will obtain the oils our parish will use in the upcoming year for the sacraments of confirmation, anointing of the sick and baptism.

The Mass of Chrism also affords priests a golden opportunity to gather with the Archbishop for a meal and to renew our priestly vows together that we originally made the day of our respective ordinations. Large gatherings for priests in our Archdiocese have been rescinded since March of 2020 , so this Chrism Mass and luncheon should be extra powerful!

I hope that you are able to partake in the sacred Triduum, and some reminders are in order that Holy Thursday (Mass of the Lord's Supper) is scheduled to occur at 7:00pm, Good Friday liturgy of the Passion of the Lord will take place at noon, and the Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday will begin at 8:30pm, in order to ensure the presence of darkness both outside and inside the church.

I will also offer opportunities for the sacrament of reconciliation *after* the Holy Thursday and Good Friday liturgies and the church will remain open until midnight for private prayer after the Mass of the Lord's Supper. May these final days of Lent 2022 be a time of great prayer and renewal.

More to come, especially as we prepare to embark upon the Easter Season!
