From the Pastor's Pen

Dear folks,

Whatever might happen this week, Jesus is still Lord of all. He is the reason for our HOPE.



Lent: Lent is a time where we take a look at our life—as individuals, as families, as a parish community, as an Area Catholic Community, as a Church—to clean out all that we have accumulated over the past year to make room for God, and to renew our focus on God. The readings on the second Sunday of Lent capture this past year so clearly—at times it seems like God is asking us to offer Him our first-born son, and at other times it seems like He is calling us His Beloved Child. How do we know when it's God and how do we know when it's not?

The answer is simple yet difficult—we practice Lent. During this season, the Church asks us to pray AND to fast AND to show mercy. Prayer, at is very core, is being totally open to God. Fasting, at its very core, is emptying ourselves so

that we can be totally open to God. Showing mercy, at its very core, is giving to another what God has given to us. Practicing Lent is about doing all three because before we can pray, we must first fast. Before we show mercy, we must first pray. Before we fast, we must receive God's gifts.

This Lent, I invite you to consider Saint Mother Theresa's words: "Do something beautiful for God." Each day, what is the one beautiful thing you will do for God? If you struggle with where to begin or what you could do, begin with fasting from the one thing you spend most of your non-essential time on. When you would normally do that activity, stop and pray. This will help you do the one beautiful thing for God that day.

God the Father has already called you and all of us His Beloved daughter or son. God the Father loves us so much that He sent Jesus into our world so that we might know His love for each of us, and for us as His chosen people. We are blessed to be able to do something beautiful for God this Lent because He has done the most beautiful thing for us already—He offered His very Son so that we might have life.

Gratitude: Keeping the live-streaming going takes an army. Thanks to Patrick Schmitz who makes sure each day the live-streamed Mass is available for our homebound parishioners. Thank you Patrick for serving the common good in the four parishes and the greater Church.

Have a great week! Let's pray for each other. There are many folks in our community, in our nation and in our Church who are experiencing the depths of anguish these days. Our prayer for each other has the power to lift up others during the times when they need it most. One possible Lenten practice: take out the new directory, and each day, pray for one family from our Area Catholic Community. —Father Matthew
