Our ACC Pastoral Council met this past week in the regular every-other-month meeting. We are looking at our strategic plan for the ACC. Part of the action steps for each goal is to find ways to include all members of our ACC, young and old, English and Spanish speakers, traditionalists and progressives. One of the first things we will be working towards is a hold-over step from our pre-COVID plan of hosting a community wide picnic in the late Spring/early Summer with a community Mass outdoors. We need to gather with the sole purpose of being together. There will be no fundraising or other agendas—just to enjoy our community. Please look for more details in the coming months.

In January our individual Councils of each parish will meet, beginning with an open session for parishioners who wish to share their thoughts and ideas. The Council members will just listen during the open session so that as many different thoughts and ideas can be gathered. Please join us if you are able.

Please plan on joining us for Masses this Christmas (see schedule below). Please note that there will not be Saturday evening Masses next week (it's Christmas Day!)—we will have regular Masses on Sunday morning.


