I cannot honestly believe we're in the new year already—it seems like we just started 2020. How time flies! Let's pray together that this coming year is filled with health, good cheer and much joy!

We are in need of workers for our new child center located at Saints Peter & Paul. The space is ready, the rooms are prepared and all we need to open is for people to care for the amazing young people. In January our individual Councils of each parish will meet, beginning with an open session for parishioners who wish to share their thoughts and ideas. The Council members will just listen during the open session so that as many different thoughts and ideas can be gathered. Please join us if you are able. We begin on January 13 at Saint James, January 17 at MIC, January 20 at Saints Peter & Paul and January 27 at Saint Boniface. All these open sessions begin at 6:00 PM and will conclude by 6:45 so that each Council can also conduct its regular agenda.

Last month the Louisville Institute announced its 2022 Pastoral Study Project grant awardees. Yours truly appears on this list for a project to study best practices in pastoral ministry in multi-parish settings. In the fall of 2022 I will be away, first to walk the Camino of Santiago in Spain and then to be mentored by a seasoned pastor in the art of multi-parish leadership. I will be working with the Abbey to have assistance for Masses while I am away. In the coming months, our Ministry Team will continue to work with Mike Roth and his Reventus Partners (reventusllc.com) to help us be prepared for the Pastoral Leadership Team to guide the parishes in my absence.

The Councils will be discussing the Pastoral Council's Strategic Plan. The PC, building on the work of the Ministry, is articulating goals around creating a sense of community, creating a culture of stewardship and promoting faith enrichment. The Councils will be discussing how each parish can contribute to achieving these goals by defining concrete actions steps. More information will be coming as the discussions continue with the individual councils and with the Pastoral Council.

This coming Friday, January 7, will be Jan Luthen's final day as the Administrator of the Assumption Community as she enters her second retirement. Jan has been a rock star in the Assumption Community, guiding the Community with a steady and gentle hand. She is a woman of deep faith and passion for senior living. I am going to miss her great sense of humor and her ability to see God's hand in everything. Thank you Jan for your amazing service!

As I am writing this, we are in the process of negotiating with an Administrator *pro tem* until we can find a hire a new Administrator.

As we welcome this new year, let us work together in Christian charity to make our parishes, our homes, and our hearts glow with Christ's radiant presence. Let's pray for one another.

The Light of the Moon

If you own a tv that has been turned on in the last month or so, chances are you've caught at least a scene or two of the 1946 classic film "It's a Wonderful Life."

If you're not familiar with the movie, it follows the life of George Bailey from childhood through adulthood. A dreamer by nature, George has big plans for himself that involve world exploration and adventure - but family and community obligations keep him tethered to the same spot on the map, leading an altogether ordinary life.

One of the most memorable scenes is of George dancing with his sweetheart Mary while they sing "Buffalo Gals - Won't you come out tonight/And dance by the light of the moon?"

That lyric always catches my ear. Of course, the moon doesn't have any light of its own. All the moon has is the ability to reflect the light that shines upon it.

The same holds for us, doesn't it? Our stewardship is purely a reflection of the grace granted to us by another. "Upon you the LORD shines," writes Isaiah, "and over you appears his glory." Every good action we will ever take begins in the mind of God. The fact that we have the honor of carrying it out on His behalf is a beautiful gift. It is God that makes our ordinary lives extraordinary.

In the end of the movie, George realizes that he had a far greater life because, instead of being the hero of his own story, he allowed himself to reflect goodness onto others.

Remember — the magi didn't chart their own course. They merely followed the star.

Nathan is the 15-year-old son of Brian and Mary Ruhland. He is currently a 9th grader at Bacon High School. Nathan was born with aortic stenosis and has undergone several heart surgeries in his short life. Unfortunately, there isn't much more the heart doctors can do for him. In October 2021, Nathan was approved to be added to the heart transplant list.

The transplant journey is long and costly. Nathan's family is hoping to offset some of the costs through a fundraiser. Fundraising proceeds will benefit COTA in honor of Nathan to assist with transplant-related expenses.
