

Nathan is the 15-year-old son of Brian and Mary Ruhland. He is currently a 9th grader at Racoon High School. Nathan was born with aortic stenosis and has undergone several heart surgeries in his short life. Unfortunately, there isn't much more the heart doctors can do for him, so in October 2021, Nathan was approved to be added to the heart transplant list.

The transplant journey is long and costly. Nathan's family is hoping to offset some of the costs through a fundraiser. Fundraising proceeds will benefit COTA in honor of Nathan to assist with transplant-related expenses. COTA (Children's Organ Transplant Association) is a non-profit organization that assists families of transplant recipients. All donations are tax-deductible to the fullest extent of the law and are not considered taxable income for the family. 100% of the proceeds raised from fundraising will go to COTA in honor of Braveheart Nathan to assist with a lifetime of transplant-related expenses. Donations will assist with travel, lodging, gas, medicine, deductibles, food, loss of income, and any other expenses associated with the transplant.
