

Dear folks,

Happy Season of the Year (aka Ordinary Time)!

As we initiate this new season *of the year*, we remember our call to live the mission of Jesus: to make and form followers of Him who called us first. We make and form His followers by entering with each other in a deeper relationship with Jesus (a culture of prayer), by sharing our experiences with Him (a culture of discipleship) and by returning what we have received from Him with others (a culture of teamwork). This is tough work, and we need to each and every day remind ourselves that Jesus asks us to make and form His followers. Recently I was challenged to answer the question of motivation for doing this, and my answer is because I love Jesus. However, I am not great at follow through with things—and I need to daily live my motivation. I also need you to join with me to live the mission of Jesus in this Area Catholic Community.



We have begun hosting meetings of site councils in each parish, beginning with a forty-five minute open meeting. This coming week Mary of the Immaculate Conception meets on Monday and Saints Peter & Paul on Thursday, both starting at 6:00 PM. The purpose of these open meetings is to simply allow people to share thoughts, ideas, hopes and dreams. If you plan to share at these meetings, I would ask that you prepare your thoughts in the most constructive manner possible. It can be too easy to share negativity which helps no one other than oneself. We are trying to work together to fulfill Christ's mission that He gave us. Please pray about what you would share and how you can build up this local community. I look forward to our gatherings.

I am acutely aware as I write this message that COVID is once again changing our realities. I don't know what will be next, but once again I beg you to practice basic Christian charity. I beg you to think about what another person might be experiencing—even if you disagree with his/her fundamental approach—and look to see the face of Christ in the other. One symptom of our present time is that we often give ourselves the benefit of the doubt (I cut someone off because I'm having a bad day) but slam another person (she/he cut me off because she/he is a bad driver). We must as Christians act differently from what we see others doing. Pray that the change begins with us.

As we started the new year, we tried to clean up the prayer list. As a ministry team, we pray for the folks listed at our daily prayer. But as one person called to ask, "How does one get off the prayer list?" If you want to be added or taken off, please contact Deb in the Community Office. We will reset the list annually so that we make sure it stays current.

During these days of the year, let us welcome Christ's love and share it with each and every person we meet. We






