Our Journey with Christ

Dear folks:

Christ is Risen! He is truly Risen! Alleluia!

Welcome—To all who are joining us whether for the first time or for the millionth time, we are so happy to have you celebrate with us the most important moment in the history of our world. Your presence with us matters. Thank you.

First Communion—Congratulations to our second graders who are receiving their First Communion at Mary of the Immaculate Conception this weekend. May the presence of the Risen Christ in the Eucharist fill them with his joy and peace!

Mary of the Immaculate Conception News—A huge thank you to everyone who made the various projects successful. The whole church simply is stunning thanks to the efforts of parishioners and local businesses who worked hard and quickly to paint, re-floor, rewire, create woodwork and bring it all together—thank you. The Council will talk about next steps in the fall. Right now, we will enjoy the beauty of the refurbished space.

Saint Boniface News—Spring is almost here, which also means projects will begin when supplies and crews are available. The front steps are the most noticeable—we need to repair the concrete to prevent dangerous falls. Please stay tuned.

Saints Peter & Paul News—This summer the HVAC system in the Parish Center is going to be replaced with a new system. This necessitates the need to move the Child Care Center while the system is replaced. The school is likely to have work done this summer, so the Child Care Center will move to the Discipleship Formation wing at Saint Boniface (below the Community Offices in the NW corner of the building). The Child Care Center will move back to Richmond by August 15. This summer we will also be looking for a new Director of Maintenance as Joe Willenbring has announced

his retirement this August. We are so grateful to Joe to his dedication to Saints Peter & Paul!

Saint James News—Germaine Hall is truly going to receive the long-awaited facelift! Crews will begin work in May (if the supply chain comes through) to replace the siding and roofing, trim and doors of Germaine Hall. Father Cletus, the dogs and I cannot wait for the excitement to begin.

New Council members—In May we will be receiving nominations for new Council members in each parish. If you know someone who would be a good candidate—they are over 18, received the Sacrament of Confirmation, and have belonged to the parish for over a year, please speak to him/her to see if he/she would be willing to serve in this important role in the parish. The Council for each parish serves as the primary advisory group for me regarding the needs of the parish as the parishes work together with the other parishes of the Area Catholic Community.

Community Census—This summer we will be moving to a single database for the four parishes. As we have been meeting with representatives from database companies and with other parishes in our diocese, it is clear that we do not have up-to-date or complete information about our community members. We will be conducting an on-line (with hard copies available) census during the month of May. We will be asking for birthdates, baptismal dates, Confirmation dates, addresses, phone numbers for your family. The information will not be shared or sold. It is so that we can serve you best. Thanks in advance for your assistance in helping us migrate to the new system.

Fundraisers—This last week we began two major fundraisers at SB and SSPP. See page 3 for more info.

We're hiring—In addition to our Director of Worship position and the SSPP Director of Maintenance, we have open positions at each school that will be posted later this week.

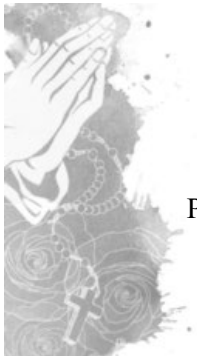
