First Communion—Congratulations to our second graders who are receiving their First Communion at **Saint Boniface** this weekend. May the presence of the Risen Christ in the Eucharist fill them with his joy and peace!

Pastoral Council News—The Pastoral Council of our ACC met on April 21. At the Council meeting, Megan Koll shared the Elementary Discipleship Program (EDF) went well this past year as well as plans for next year. VBS is scheduled for June 20-24. 




