Christ is Risen! He is truly Risen! Alleluia!

Welcome—To all who are joining us, we are so happy to have you celebrate with us. Your presence with us matters. Thank you.

First Communion—Congratulations to our second graders who are receiving their First Communion at **Saint Boniface** this weekend. May the presence of the Risen Christ in the Eucharist fill them with his joy and peace!

Pastoral Council News—The Pastoral Council of our ACC met on April 21. At the Council meeting, Megan Koll shared the Elementary Discipleship Program (EDF) went well this past year as well as plans for next year. VBS is scheduled for June 20-24. Chad Bauer shared the Teen and Young Adult Discipleship Formation Program also went well. This summer we have students going to Colorado to serve the poor.
