

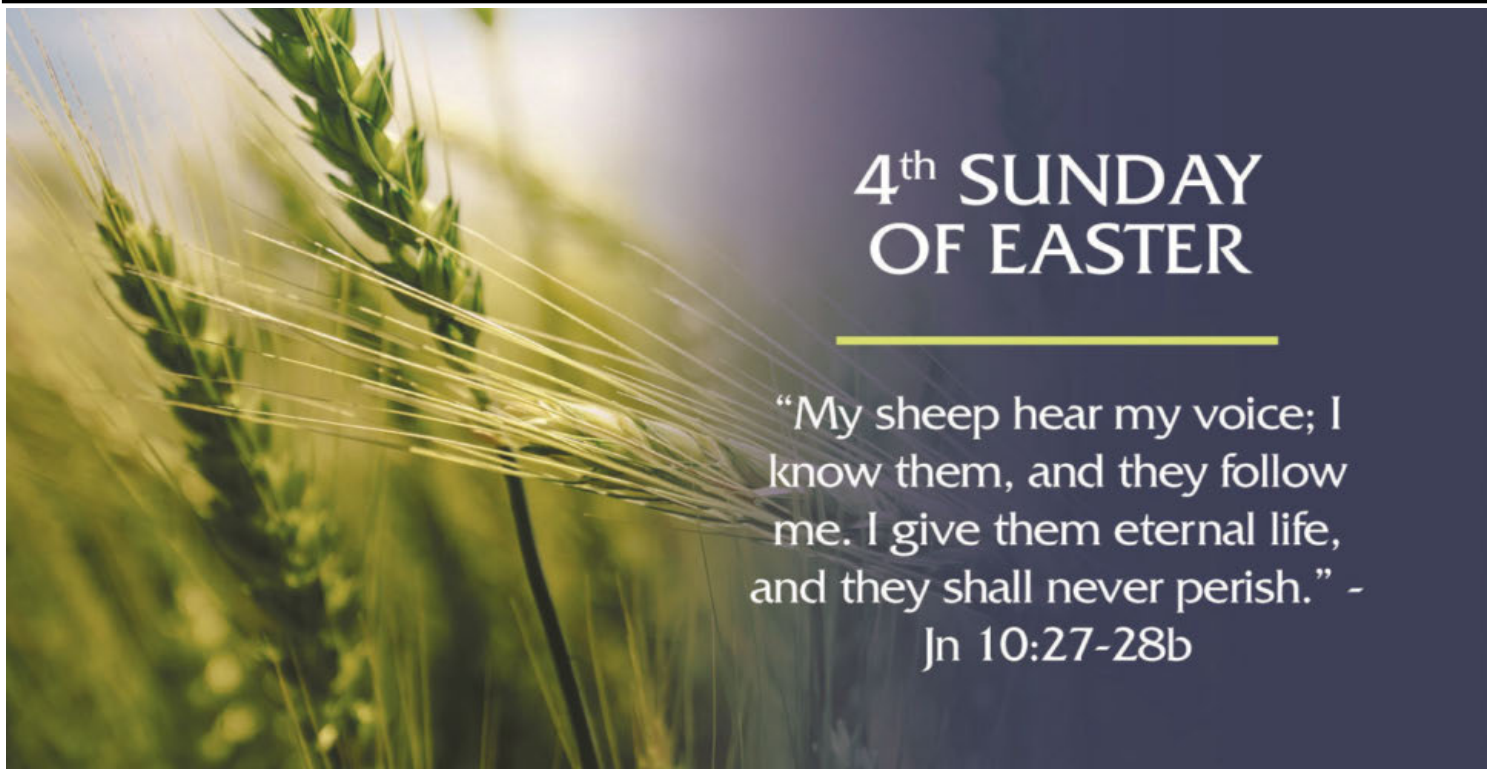

Dear folks:

Christ is Risen! He is truly Risen! Alleluia!

Happy Mothers' Day—To all who have given life to another human being, we wish you a most blessed day. May God's love be poured forth on you today.

First Communion—Congratulations to our second graders who are receiving their First Communion at **Saints Peter & Paul** this weekend. May the presence of the Risen Christ in the Eucharist fill them with his joy and peace!

What's in a name? Last week in the bulletin as well as in the Sunday announcements, I announced that we needed new members for the "Parish Life Committee." Since then, many have asked, "What is the *"Parish Life Committee?"*" Well, that's an interesting question because in trying to clarify, I created more confusion. Right now there are five distinct "Councils" with similar names: the Pastoral Council which serves the ACC, the Council of MIC, the Council of SB, the Council of SSPP and the Council of SJ. *What's the difference among these Councils?* The focus of the Pastoral Council is the collaborative mission and vision of the ACC. The individual Council of each parish focuses on the particular needs of each parish. All five of these groups serve as the advisory group to me in relation to their particular focus. In trying to get away from the confusion of the difference between the Pastoral Council and a parish's Council (as some of these Councils were previously called Parish Councils and others Pastoral Councils), I caused more confusion—I'm sorry about this. We will be fielding suggestions from each individual Council to come up with a common distinctive term for this parish group.

New members—We are receiving nominations for new members for each parish's advisory group. If you know someone who would be a good candidate—over 18, received the Sacrament of Confirmation, and have belonged to the parish for over a year, please speak to him/her to see if he/she would be willing to serve in this important role in the parish. The group serves as the primary advisory group for me regarding the needs of the individual parish as the parishes work together with the other parishes of the Area Catholic Community. Forms are available in the churches as well as in the Community Office.

Community Census—This summer we will be moving to a single database for the four parishes. We do not have up-to-date or complete information about our community members. We will be conducting an on-line (with hard copies available) census during the month of May. We will be asking for birthdates, baptismal dates, Confirmation dates, addresses, phone numbers for your family. The information will not be shared or sold. It is so that we can serve you best. Thanks in advance for your assistance in helping us migrate to the new system.

We're hiring—In addition to our Director of Worship position and the SSPP Maintenance Technician, we have open positions for a fifth grade teacher at SBS and a Head Cook for SSPPS and Child Care. Please pray for the right persons for these positions in our community.

On retreat—This week I am on retreat at New Melleray Abbey in Peosta, Iowa. Please keep me in prayer as I pray for our Area Catholic Community.

Cemetery Cleanup will be May 14. Please help us keep our cemetery beautiful. Bring rakes & shovels. If you have questions, call Al Gertken.

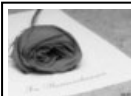
