Our Journey with Christ

Dear folks:

Christ is Risen! He is truly Risen! Alleluia!

First Communion—Congratulations to our second graders who are receiving their First Communion at **Saint James** this weekend. May the presence of the Risen Christ in the Eucharist fill them with his joy and peace!

What's a sabbatical? What is a Pastoral Program? What are you doing? I know some looked up “sabbatical” and still don't quite understand what I am doing for six month. The shorter version is simple: a sabbatical is a way to keep holy the Sabbath day by spending time to rest, relax and renew oneself. I have been given six months to do this.

Yet, there is a hitch—I have to produce something for the money I am receiving to take the sabbatical. In other words, in order to rest, I have to work. But the work that I will be undertaking is creative. The project I am undertaking is spending time in parish groupings in Iowa in order to feel better prepared to minister in our ACC. As a seminarian, my focus of studies was primarily geared towards teaching graduate students. As such, I did not ever take course work or have hands-on preparation for parish administration, parish ministry or the like. I was assigned to Saint Boniface right after ordination with the idea that I would get “real experience” in order to teach others how to celebrate Mass, preach in a parish and celebrate the Sacraments.

When I went off for doctoral studies in 2008, I was supposed to be done with full-time parish ministry. Early on in the graduate program, the Holy Spirit kept moving me to have the hard conversation with the Abbot and others that I should be in parish work. That I did—with the caveat that I should finish the degree in order to better serve the Church.

So when I finished the doctoral program in 2013, I was assigned first to Saint Boniface, then in 2017 to Saint James and Saints Peter & Paul, and finally in 2020 to Mary of the Immaculate Conception. Through it all, I have been relying upon the Holy Spirit to lead and guide me—at times doing so well and other times getting in the Spirit's way. In order to better serve in our local community, I need to spend some time as a disciple learning how to be a better pastor, and to do so with others who have the experience with more complex situations.

I will be spending time meeting with experience pastors, staff members in multiple parish groups, leadership groups and community members learning what worked well and what has not worked well. I am in the process of developing a questionnaire of things to ask and find out about.

The true relaxing and rejuvenating part of this sabbatical will be walking the Camino de Santiago through Spain. I plan to walk the VIA DE LA PLATA, a 1000 km route that starts from southwestern Spain in Seville (where I lived for four months during college in a study abroad program) and ends at the tomb of Saint James the Greater in Compestela, Spain.

While I am away, the Bishop will assign a Canonical Administrator, a priest whose sole task is to keep the ship afloat in my absence. I will remain Pastor and will return in February. The canonical administrator will be a diocesan priest as there is not a priest from Saint John's who is able to take on our ACC. Father Cletus will remain here as well, celebrating daily Masses, anointings and the myriad of other things he already does.

Please keep me in prayer during this time as I spend the time learning to be a better pastor for all of you.

Parish Groups meet this week—The advisory leadership group from the parishes meet this week to talk about budget, a request from Youth Ministry for the Mass schedule and a name for the group.
