## Pastor's Reflection

**T**he Holy Week begins with the triumphant entry of the Lord Jesus into Jerusalem. He enters riding on a donkey, and the poor and destitute of the city acclaim him as their king, carpeting the ground with their cloaks and palm branches. What did the people who acclaimed him see in Jesus of Nazareth? They saw a king who came to free them from everything that afflicted and bothered them: disease, hunger, violence, and the oppression and exploitation of their masters.

But this liberating king entered the city without an army and without weapons. He entered in peace and with a peacemaking attitude. He came to free them with the power of God, not with the power of weapons. It was going to be God himself who, in an extraordinary way, would free them through this great king and prophet. That is why they excitedly acclaimed: "Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord."

But, as we see later in the account of the Passion, these same people were going to cry out in fury: Crucify him! What happened that they, who a few days earlier had acclaimed Christ as King and Lord, were now demanding his crucifixion and death?

What happened was that these people had allowed themselves to be deceived and manipulated by the authorities and the powerful of their time, who saw in our Lord Jesus an enemy of

their hypocrisy, their thefts, and their ambitions. But it is also possible that many of these people felt disappointed because Jesus of Nazareth had not immediately and aggressively resolved all the political and economic problems that troubled them. They had expected that this prophet to free them by force of arms from all their physical and material troubles and from all their political enemies. Instead, Jesus of Nazareth had limited himself to proclaiming peace, mercy, and conversion of heart, and asking them to forgive their enemies. Jesus of Nazareth healed their physical and mental illnesses and invited them to be merciful and help others.

Let us be careful, brothers and sisters, because this bad attitude of the people of Jerusalem is the same attitude we sometimes have. While everything is going well for us, we say: how good God is with me. But if things go badly and we suffer misfortune and pain, then we say: how unjust God is to me. What kind of liberator do we await today? We await the one who comes in the name of the Lord, Jesus Christ. He has come to invite us to change our hearts and purify our conduct. He has come to encourage us to work for the kingdom that he has already begun: a kingdom of truth and life, of forgiveness, justice, solidarity, and peace.
