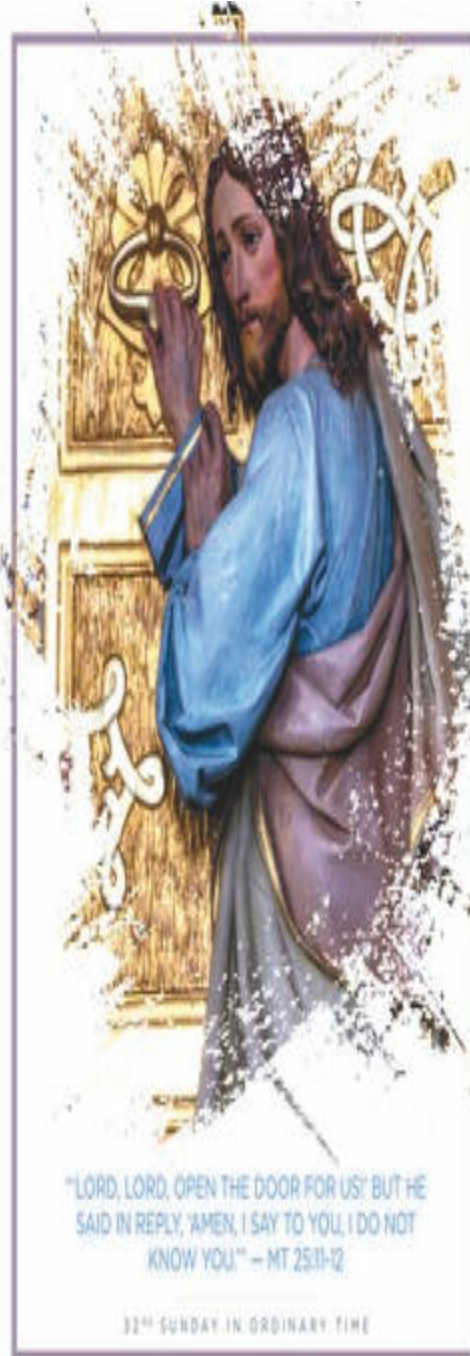

**FROM FR. JOE**

*May St. Martin of Tours, pray for our veterans!*

November 11, this Wednesday, is Veterans Day. This date recalls the date of the Armistice for World War I, November 11, 1918. Often referred to as "The Great War", many thought that WWI would be "the war to end all wars". Obviously, that phrase did not prove accurate. There can be a lot of debates between people over whether or not a particular war or conflict can be considered just or unjust. We might not be able to all agree on which wars are just. However, I do believe that we American Catholics have long and deep respect for our veterans, especially our deceased veterans, even if we do not completely agree with the war they fought in.

I have often thought it quite appropriate that Veterans Day is the same day as the Memorial of St. Martin of Tours in the Catholic Church. St. Martin was born in present day Hungary and grew up in Italy. He was forced to become a soldier, but he was eventually baptized a Christian and recognized that he was called to be a soldier for Christ. After some difficulty, he convinced his commander to discharge him and he began his life as a monk. Later on he was named the third Bishop of Tours, France. He worked hard against the practice of putting heretics to death, and instead emphasized mercy. He is known as the patron saint of soldiers and of France.

May Saint Martin continue to pray for all of and especially our veterans. The following is a Prayer for Deceased Veterans that the U.S. Bishops have published.

**O God,**

***by whose mercy the faithful departed find rest,***

***look kindly on your departed veterans who gave their lives in the service of their country.***

***Grant that through the passion, death, and resurrection of your Son they may share in the joy of your heavenly kingdom and rejoice in you with your saints forever.***

***We ask this through Christ our Lord.***

This weekend we hear the Parable of the 10 virgins. *In light of this, Jesus said, we must stay awake—that is, be spiritually vigilant and mindful the Bridegroom will indeed come. For now, we live in a "time of waiting and watching" (CCC, 672).*

We are given the Holy Spirit, but we are required to obey the Spirit and expand our capacity for receiving more of the Holy Spirit. We are responsible for our own "oil", we cannot rely on anyone else to fill our lamp for us. This is why the wise virgins could not share their oil. I cannot borrow your relationship with God. So the foolish virgins lacking the oil of the Spirit go off to get some. The text does not say that they return with oil. They simply show up at the wedding and want in. But they cannot come in. Why? Because they still do not have the oil of the Spirit.

They have not in any way prepared themselves for a relationship with the Bridegroom any more than the couch potato has prepared himself to run in a marathon. The Big Day is here and they cannot meet it because they have not prepared in any way. Nobody can do it for you. You have to do it yourself. So how are you preparing?
