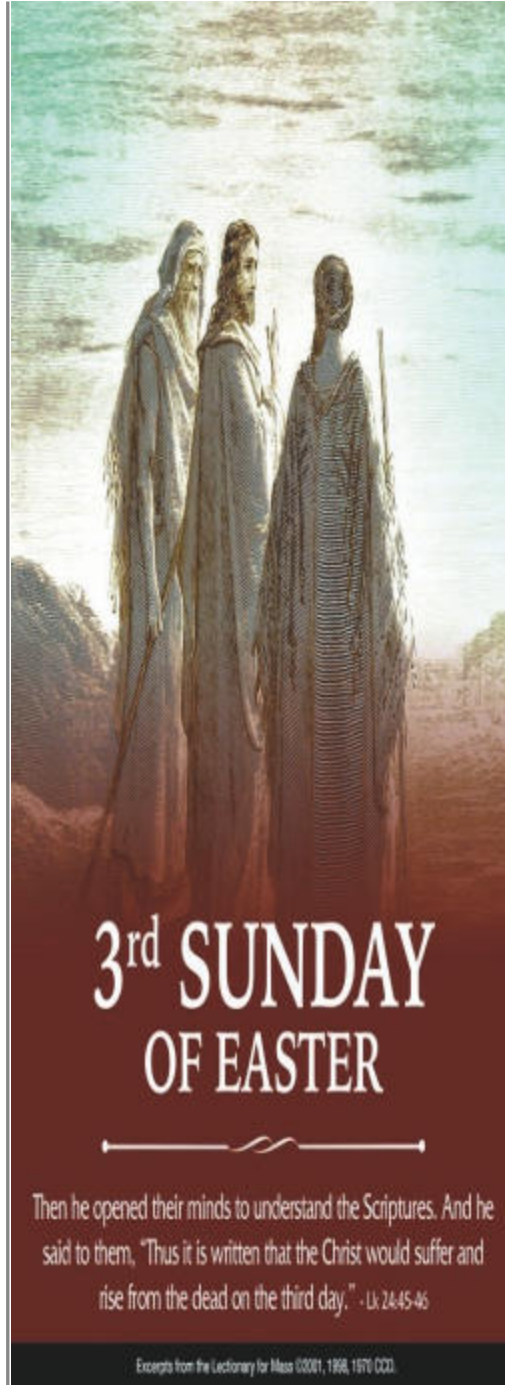

**FROM FR. JOE**

***Regina Caeli (Queen of Heaven)***

I have mentioned before that priests, deacons, religious, and others in the Church make a promise to say several prayers throughout the day. Just before bed, we say a night prayer which ends with a prayer or hymn to Our Lady. Most of the year it is the "Hail Holy Queen" or *Salve Regina* in Latin, but in Eastertime we say a prayer called "Queen of Heaven" or *Regina Caeli*. I have seen a few different translations and versions of this prayer around, but here is a copy both in English and Latin from [www.ewtn.com](http://www.ewtn.com).

**Queen of Heaven**

V. Queen of Heaven, rejoice, alleluia.  
R. For He whom you did merit to bear, alleluia.  
V. Has risen, as he said, alleluia.  
R. Pray for us to God, alleluia.  
V. Rejoice and be glad, O Virgin Mary, alleluia.  
R. For the Lord has truly risen, alleluia.

Let us pray. O God, who gave joy to the world through the resurrection of Thy Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, grant we beseech Thee, that through the intercession of the Virgin Mary, His Mother, we may obtain the joys of everlasting life. Through the same Christ our Lord. Amen.
