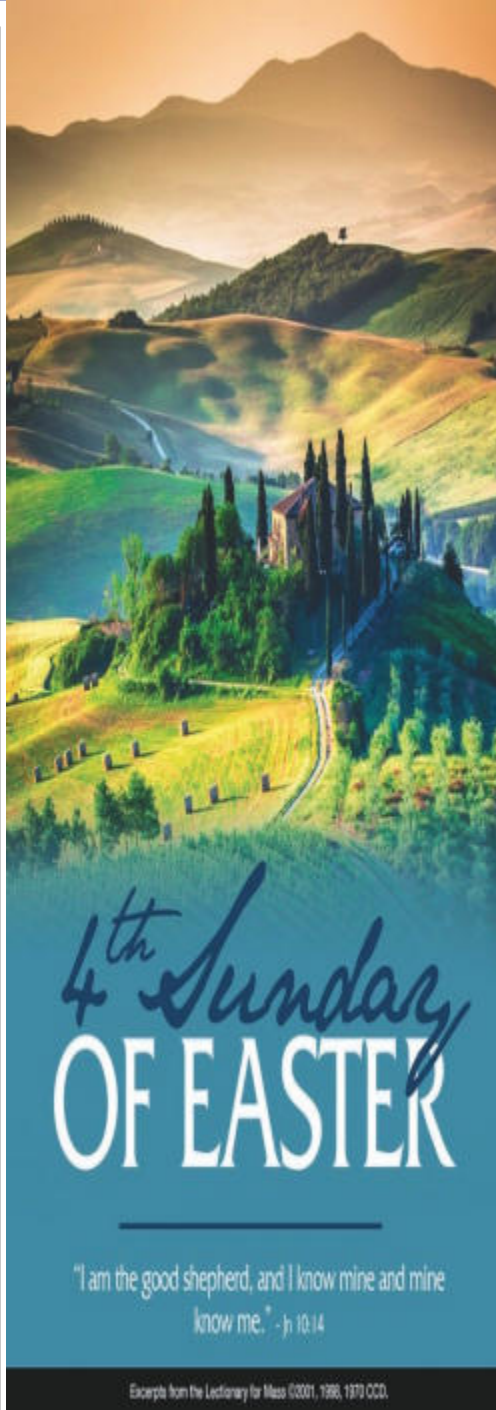

## FROM FR. JOE

### **FR. DANIEL FELTON – BISHOP-ELECT FOR THE DIOCESE OF DULUTH**

As you have no doubt already heard, we have a new bishop-elect for our diocese: Fr. Daniel Felton. The following information is from a press release the Diocese of Duluth put out on April 7<sup>th</sup>.

“Bishop-elect Felton, who has served as vicar general and moderator of the curia for the Diocese of Green Bay since 2014, was born Feb. 5, 1955. He is the son of Carol and the late Ken Felton and the oldest of five children and attended St. Edward School in Mackville, Wis., and Appleton West in Appleton. He holds a bachelor's degree from St. Norbert College in De Pere, Wis., in religious studies and psychology; a master's degree in theology from St. John University, Collegeville; and a licentiate of sacred theology and a master's degree in social communications from the Gregorian University in Rome.

“Bishop-elect Felton was ordained a priest on June 13, 1981, by Bishop Aloysius Wycislo for the Green Bay Diocese. His parish assignments have included Holy Innocents in Manitowoc, St. Raphael the Archangel in Oshkosh, and St. Francis of Assisi Parish in Manitowoc. Father Felton was also the director of affiliate affairs for the Catholic Telecommunications Network of America.

“Father Felton serves as a member of the diocesan College of Consultants, Presbyteral Council, Bishop Advisory Council, Personnel Board, Diocesan Finance Council, St. Norbert Board of Trustees, and Silver Lake College Board of Directors. He is also a member of the National Advisory Council of the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops.”

As we can see, Bishop-elect Felton has plenty of experience as a pastor as well as experience with administration and the inner workings of a diocese. From what I have observed of our last few bishops, such experience is important for a bishop. I am very excited to meet him and hopefully have him come visit us in the not too distant future.

This weekend, the Fourth Sunday of Easter, is often called Good Shepherd Sunday, because the Gospel comes from Jesus' teachings on the Good Shepherd. The bishop of a diocese is often called its shepherd. This is symbolized by the crozier the bishop carries, which looks like a shepherd's crook. May the Holy Spirit inspire Bishop-elect Felton to be the shepherd we need to lead us in the coming years!

### **From Mari Jo Anderson: Director of Religious Education**

Confirmation deepens our baptismal life that calls us to be missionary witnesses of Jesus Christ in our families, neighborhoods, society, and the world. Through Confirmation, our personal relationship with Christ is strengthened. We receive the message of faith in a deeper and more intensive manner with great emphasis given to the person of Jesus Christ, who asked the Father to give the Holy Spirit to the Church for building up the community in loving service.

The Holy Spirit bestows seven gifts—wisdom, understanding, knowledge, fortitude, counsel, piety, and fear of the Lord—to assist us in our mission and witness. The impact of these gifts accompanies us in the various stages of our spiritual development.

As the confirmed, we walk with the seven gifts of the Holy Spirit. Wisdom enables us to see the world from God's viewpoint, which can help us come to grasp the purpose and plan of God. It grants us the long-range view of history, examining the present in the light of the past and the mystery of the future. It saves us from the illusion that the spirit of the times is our only guide. The Spirit's gift of knowledge directs us to a contemplation, or thoughtful reflection, of the mystery of God—Father, Son, and Holy Spirit—as well as of the mysteries of the Catholic faith. We are drawn to meditative prayer, where we allow God to lead us while we rest patiently in the divine presence.

This weekend our Confirmation students, plus several others from our Deanery were able to attend their Confirmation retreat. Please keep these students in your prayers as their Confirmation draws near. May we all reflect on our own Confirmation, and remember we are called to be His witnesses.
