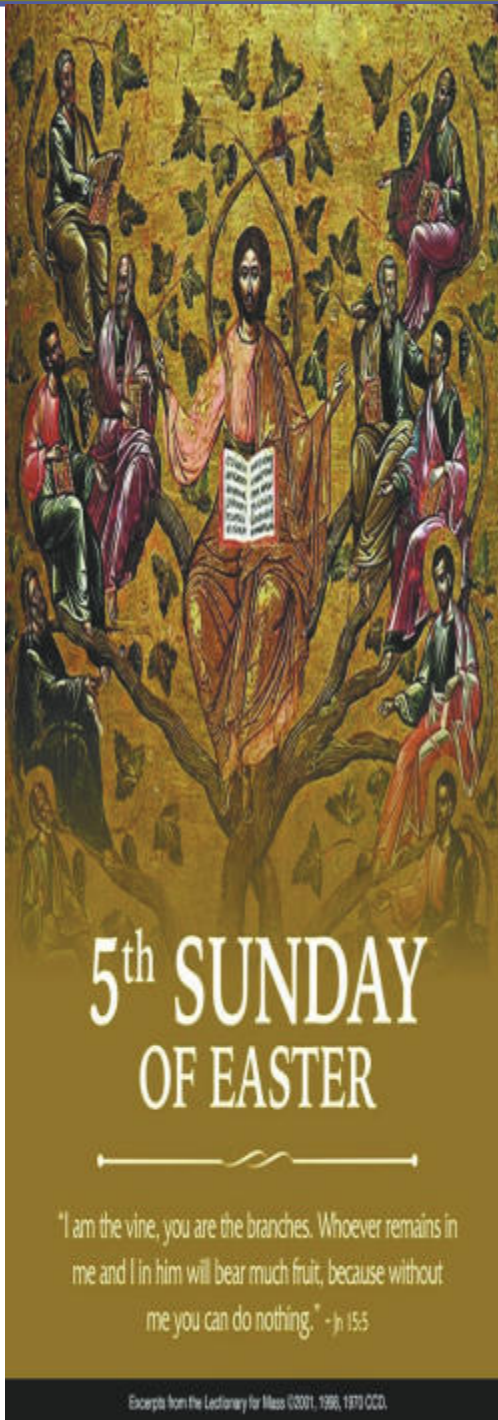

REMINDER OF ONLINE GIVING!

As many of you already know, we have been running online giving pages for both parishes on our website for over a year now! We have had a lot of people sign up for this very convenient method of giving, but I would like to encourage more people to join. For those of you who have not yet taken advantage of this, please take a look at the insert in this bulletin.

As the insert explains, simply go to www.scmicatholic.com and then click on "St. Cecilia's Online Giving" or "Mary Immaculate Online Giving" depending on which parish you wish to give to. This will take you to the "We Share" page where you can make a donation to our regular Sunday collection or to the United Catholic Appeal. At the St. Cecilia page you can also pay your child's Religious Education fees. Just click on "Make a Donation" and you will choose to make a one time or recurring payment.

After indicating how much you want to donate, how often you want to make and what account or card you are taking the money from, you will also set up an account. Your account will allow you log in and set up other any other donations you might want to make. The nice thing is, once you are set up, you no longer have to worry about remembering to bring a check or money with you to Mass. Think about it! You never have to worry about remembering your envelope or checkbook or having the right amount of cash on hand again. And you can still give even if you go on vacation.

I personally am very glad we were able to set up this online giving before the pandemic hit last year. I am not sure if our parish finances would have stayed afloat without at least some money coming in through online donations. So thank you to all those who signed up and kept giving. If you are still dragging your feet, please consider signing up. I realize that people are nervous about signing up for something like this, especially when you read about websites being hacked in the news. Please understand that this form of giving is both safe and reliable. The company that runs it (the same company that prints our bulletins) works diligently to make sure everything is safe and trustworthy.

I encourage you to log on to the website and check this out. Do not worry; we will still have the envelopes available so you can put your donation in the collection basket if you prefer to do it that way. We hope this will be a convenient way for people to give. Call the office if you have any questions.

The month of May is the "month which the piety of the faithful has especially dedicated to Our Blessed Lady," the Queen of Heaven. The Blessed Virgin Mary is the Mother of the Church and therefore the example, as well as the guide and inspiration, of everyone who, in and through the Church, seeks to be the servant of God and man and the obedient agent of the promptings of the Holy Spirit.

In May of 2002 Pope John Paul II said, "Today we begin the month dedicated to Our Lady, a favourite of popular devotion. In accord with a long-standing tradition of devotion, parishes and families continue to make the month of May a 'Marian' month, celebrating it with many devout liturgical, catechetical and pastoral initiatives!"

In our observance of the Marian month we should take into account the season of the Liturgical Year which largely corresponds with the fifty days of Easter. Our pious exercises could emphasize Our Lady's participation in the Paschal mystery and in Pentecost with which the Church begins. The pious exercises connected with the month of May can easily highlight the earthly role played by the glorified Queen of Heaven, here and now, in the celebration of the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Eucharist.

The following practices which are recommended by the Magisterium are offered as suggestions for honoring Our Lady during Her month. This month our 11th Grade students will be Confirmed and our 2nd Graders will receive their First Holy Communion, please pray for them as they prepare to receive these Blessed Sacraments.
