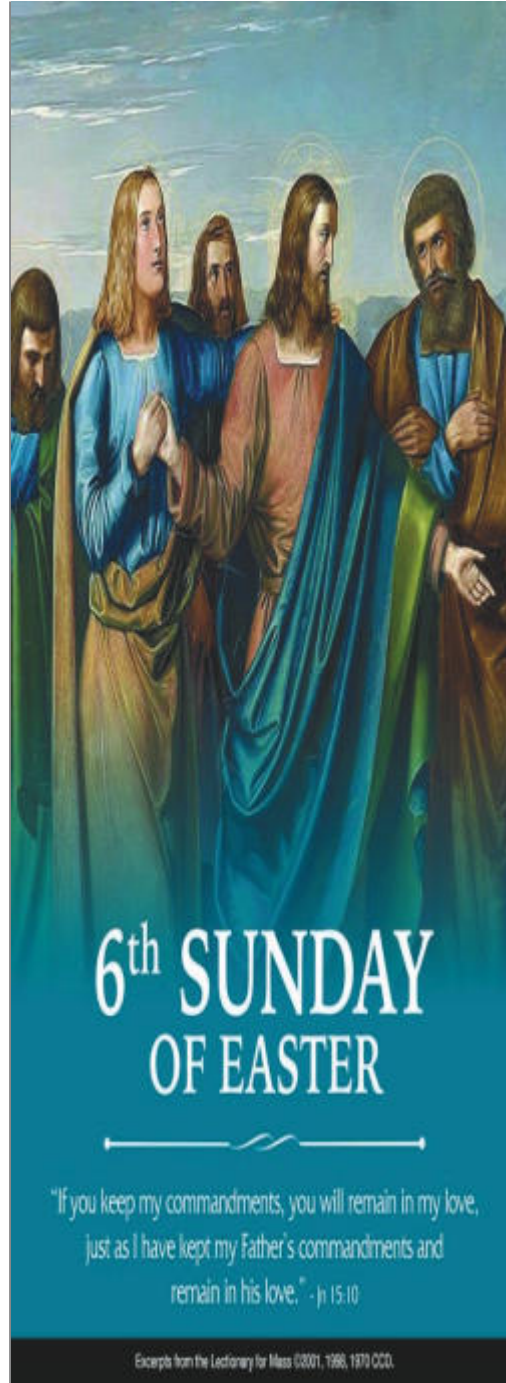

FROM FR. JOE

“I have heard people say if you pray the Chaplet of Divine Mercy at the bedside of a dying person that they will go directly to Heaven. Is this true?”

Yes! This is true. St. Maria Faustina Kowalska, to whom Jesus first taught the Divine Mercy Chaplet to in 1935, talks about this in her diary. In paragraph 810, St. Faustina describes being prompted to pray the Chaplet for a dying person. Before even being able to finish the Chaplet, the person died “with extraordinary peace”, she said. In the next paragraph, she explains that God told her:

“At the hour of their death, I defend as My own glory every soul that will say this chaplet; or when others say it for a dying person, the pardon is the same. When this chaplet is said by the bedside of a dying person, God's anger is placated, unfathomable mercy envelopes the soul, and the very depths of My tender mercy are moved for the sake of the sorrowful Passion of My Son.”

Jesus also told her on paragraph 1541:

“My daughter, encourage souls to say the chaplet which I have given you. It pleases Me to grant everything they ask of Me by saying the chaplet. When hardened sinners say it, I will fill their souls with peace, and the hour of their death will be a happy one. ... Write that when they say this chaplet in the presence of the dying, I will stand between My Father and the dying person, not as the just Judge but as the merciful Savior.”

These are very powerful words. We are being told that saying the Chaplet for the dying is not just a “nice thing to do”. The words are not just soothing words to the dying person or to the person saying them or to others who happen to be in the room at the time. The praying of the Chaplet actually brings about an outpouring of God's Mercy and Grace to the dying. Sins are forgiven and Christ Himself comes to stand with the person as their savior. What a wonderful gift we have is Jesus' Divine Mercy!

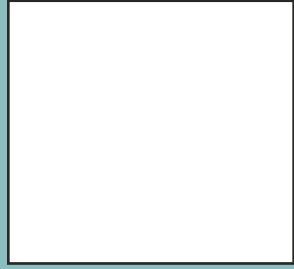
