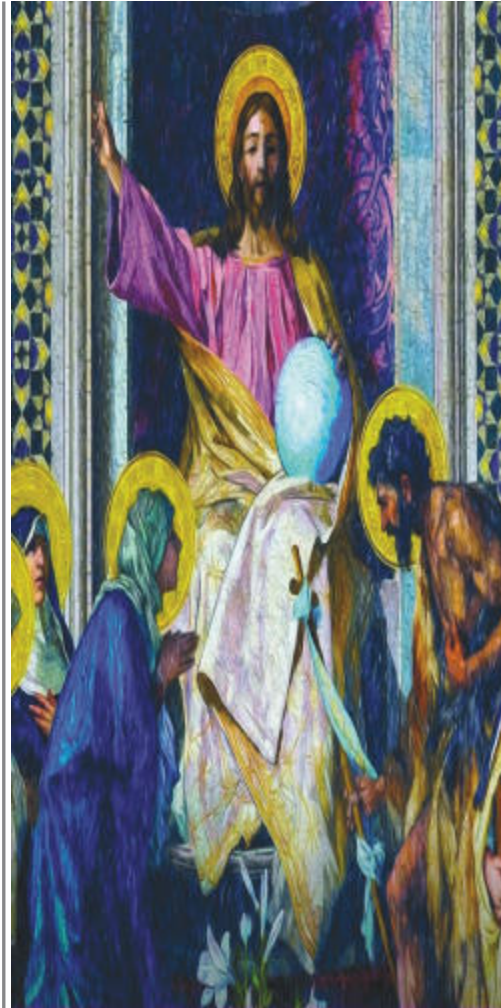

**FROM FR. JOE**

**CATHOLIC FUNERALS**

I have observed that many Catholics are confused about what a Catholic Funeral is supposed to look like. In the hope of aiding families in preparing a funeral for a loved one, I have decided to dedicate this article to talking about Catholic Funerals.

The Church offers with three distinct rites: the Wake or Visitation, the Funeral, and the Burial.

**The Wake/Visitation:** This is traditionally done the night before the funeral, either at the Funeral Home or at the Parish Church. The casket (typically open) or the urn is set up front and people can pray, visit, or console any family members. A short service (Wake Service), traditionally led by a deacon or a priest, can be held. Or sometimes the rosary or another devotion might be prayed. This is also the best time for family to get up and say a eulogy for the deceased. In the past couple of decades, many families have moved from having the wake night before to just having a time of visitation for an hour before the Funeral itself. It is up to the family what they want to do, but I cannot help but feel that we are praying less for our loved ones and cheating them out of needed graces.

**The Funeral:** The Church encourages us to have a full Funeral Mass for the deceased. This means a Mass like on Sundays, plus some extra prayers for the Final Commendation of the remains. The family can also choose to do a Funeral Service, which means we have readings, a homily, and the Final Commendation, but no Communion. People sometimes interchange "Service" and "Mass" as if they are the same thing. They are not! If you want a Mass at a Funeral, please tell the priest you want a Funeral Mass. Please do not call it a Funeral Service if that is not what you are looking for.

**The Burial:** This is typically done the same day as the Funeral, over at the cemetery. However, the burial can be delayed for the right reasons. Some want to wait until the ground thaws in the spring or summer, or if they have to transport the remains to a more distant cemetery. During this pandemic, some people delayed the burial until it was safe for a larger group to get together.

**A note on Cremation:** As many already know, it is permissible for Catholics to be cremated after death. What some people do not know is that all the cremated remains should be buried or placed in a columbarium (an above ground memorial for cremated remains) as soon as possible. The remains should not be scattered or divided among loved ones or kept in a house.

**A note on Eulogies:** Eulogies are words in honor of a loved one or friend who has passed away. They tend to talk about the person's talents and gifts and how they will be missed. As mentioned before, the most appropriate time to do this is at the wake the night before, or it can be done at the burial or at the reception. Many think the Funeral is a good place to do this. It is not. The purpose of the Funeral is to talk about the person's relationship with God and to pray that God will welcome the person into Heaven. Since they tend to praise the individual, **eulogies are not permitted in a Catholic Funeral. This will be our parishes' policy going forward.**
