#### FROM FR. JOE

#### WELCOMING THE LIGHT OF CHRIST INTO THE WORLD

Wednesday, February 2 has a deeper significance to us Catholics than just another Groundhog Day. This date marks the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord. The Gospel of Luke 2:22-24 explains that at the end of their purification, the Holy Family was required to go to Jerusalem to present Jesus to God. This makes reference to two Jewish laws. The first is found in Exodus 13:2. "Consecrate to me every firstborn; whatever opens the womb among the Israelites, whether of human being or beast, belongs to me." This also references Leviticus 12:2-8 which explains that a woman who gives birth to a son is considered unclean for seven days and is not allowed into the sanctuary of the Temple for an additional thirty-three days. When those forty days were up, they were required to go to the temple and offer up "a pair of turtledoves or two young pigeons." A quick check of a calendar tells us that February 2 is forty days after Christmas Day.

This day has also become known as Candlemas Day. For centuries, this has been the day to bless candles. The local parish would bless their supply of candles, but individual parishioners would bring their own candles to be blessed as well. Several of these newly blessed candles would then be lit and carried into the Church as a part of the opening procession for the day's Mass. The light of the candles represents the light of Christ coming into the world.

February 3 is the Memorial of St. Blaise. St. Blaise was a bishop of Sebaste in Armenia and was martyred for the faith in the early 4<sup>th</sup> Century. He has long been associated with the healing of throats. There is a story (it is hard to know if it is totally true or not) that a mother brought her son who was choking on a fish bone to the saint. He blessed the boy and the offending bone was dislodged. Catholics have long attended Mass on St. Blaise's feast day to receive the Blessing of Throats. This is traditionally done by a priest or deacon with crossed candles that were blessed the day before at Candlemas. The words of the blessing ask for healing from "every disease of the throat and from every other illness." As you can see this is a very appropriate blessing during a pandemic.

In these days, let us welcome the light of Christ into our hearts. May we be guided all the more to the Father's love.
