

From Father Bill...I hope that your Lent has been going well. It is hard to believe that we are already starting the third week. Do not grow tired in your prayers, fasting/abstinence, or any of the other Lenten disciplines that you have undertaken. One way to keep on track is to increase your prayers and other practices a little bit each week. For example, look at what you did last week and increase it. If you spent an additional half hour in prayer daily, increase it by fifteen minutes this and try for forty-five minutes. The following week, increase it by another ten or fifteen minutes. By doing these little increases each week for the remainder of Lent, you not only stay on track, you will also see significant progress when you reach the end of Lent. May God continue to bless all of you during this sacred and penitential season.


