

FATHER'S WEEKLY MESSAGE



Invite Jesus to your wedding

The Jews attached great importance to the high moments of life. Thus a wedding was not just a brief ceremony, but an experience shared by the entire community. The typical wedding feast could last up to seven days. That sounds strange to our modern way of thinking,

but this offered a bright interlude in an otherwise dreary existence. The ceremony would begin on Tuesday at midnight. After the wedding the father of the bride would take his daughter to every house so that everyone might congratulate her. It was a community experience. Weddings were a time of joy.

Years ago when Johnny Carson was the host of *The Tonight Show* he interviewed an eight year old boy. The young man was asked to appear because he had rescued two friends in a coal mine outside his hometown in West Virginia. As Johnny questioned the boy, it became apparent to him and the audience that the young man was a Christian.

So Johnny asked him if he attended Sunday school. When the boy said he did Johnny inquired, "What are you learning in Sunday school?" "Last week," came his reply, "our lesson was about when Jesus went to a wedding and turned water into wine."

Then he said, "And what did you learn from that story?" The boy squirmed in his chair. It was apparent he hadn't thought about this. But then he lifted up his face and said, "If you're going to have a wedding, make sure you invite Jesus!"

The little boy was on to something. Weddings are time of Joy.

The Cana miracle opens Jesus' ministry with a miracle of abundant gifts and grace, a miracle of hope and possibilities. John calls this miracle a "sign". This name for a miracle reminds us that miracles are more than spectacular action. They are signs that point beyond any one particular act or event to what can be seen of God in the miracle.

This sign points to Jesus' "glory". In the OT, "glory" is the term for the manifestation of God's presence and power. In the grace-filled abundance of the wine, Jesus makes visible the presence of God. (from John Shearman)


