

#### **FATHER'S WEEKLY MESSAGE**



<u>Welcome on this first Sunday of a New</u>
<u>Year.</u> I trust that one of your resolutions for this year is to be in worship every week. Good for you. That's one resolution you've kept for at least one week.

At the beginning of a New Year, a high school principal decided to post his teachers' New Year's resolutions on the bulletin

board. As the teachers gathered around the bulletin board, a great commotion started. One of the teachers was complaining. "Why weren't my resolutions posted?" She was throwing such a temper tantrum that the principal hurried to his office to see if he had overlooked her resolutions. Sure enough, he had mislaid them on his desk.

As he read her resolutions he was astounded. This teacher's first resolution was not to let little things upset her in the New Year. I don't know how you are doing on your New Year's resolutions.

I do know something that is more important than resolutions, though. How do you see this New Year? Is it one that you approach with anxiety or anticipation?

## **Living for Balance**

I read the words of Dr. Meyer Friedman, who said that lifestyle and creative use of leisure can be more important than diet and exercise in preventing heart attacks. Obviously a balance among all three is most desirable. I have observed many people who have paid attention to the body and diet and have neglected the spirit and are dying inside.

Dr. Friedman gives suggestions for people to live less frantic lives by living more by the calendar than the clock:

- 1. Stop thinking about several things at one time.
- 2. Listen without interrupting.
- 3. Read books that demand concentration (games, too).
- 4. Avoid irritating people.
- 5. Plan for some personal quiet time each day.
- 6. Finally, things worth being are better than things worth having.

Remember the people who were here first. The Native Americans had an ability to live by the ages rather than by the day. 
