Reflections from Father Daryl

Three Temptations

On this first Sunday of Lent, the Church presents to us in the gospel the three temptations of Christ. Jesus had just spent forty days in the desert in prayer and fasting preparing for his public ministry. Our Lenten observance is our way of joining our Lord in the desert to pray and fast. Jesus, the Son of God, did not need either of these practices to prepare for all that he would endure for our salvation. By spending this time in the desert, he has set for us the path by which we can conform our lives to his.

Through our prayer life, we enter a relationship with the God who loves us. It is a conversation with the one who desires the best for us and wants us to be filled with peace and joy. Jesus who was one with the Father in all things desires to be fully united to us in the same way. This union with Jesus grows when we spend time with him in prayer.

Jesus willingly gave his life on the cross for each one of us. In his sacrifice on the cross, he took on the sins of all humanity so that we could be set free from our slavery to sin. We unite ourselves to his suffering on the cross through our practice of fasting. When we fast, we deny ourselves of that which is good so that we might share in the suffering of our Lord.

Combined, prayer and fasting will give us the necessary tools to overcome the temptations we face in our lives. Jesus faced the three temptations from the devil at the end of his forty days of prayer and fasting. The temptation to change the stones into bread would have satisfied his hunger. Jesus quotes the scripture passage that man does not live on bread alone to refute the temptation. We are often tempted to use the gifts that God has given us to satisfy our personal needs only. Jesus reminds us that all has been given to us to seek the ultimate good of serving Christ in one another.

Jesus is then tempted to throw himself off the pinnacle of the temple and allow the angels to save him. Jesus responds with the scripture you shall not tempt the Lord your God. Jesus would not have needed the angels to save him for he could well have saved himself as God. We need the protection of the Lord in all things and Jesus invites us to place our complete trust in him and not in ourselves. Through Christ, all things become possible to lead us to our eternal home.

The final temptation of all the glory and power over all kingdoms to which Jesus replies, you shall worship the Lord your God and him only. Every day, we are faced with the temptation to seek glory for ourselves through the material goods that surround us. Believing these things will fill us with the happiness we desire. We are created to serve God and when we strive to serve him alone, we will find the true and lasting joy that we seek.
