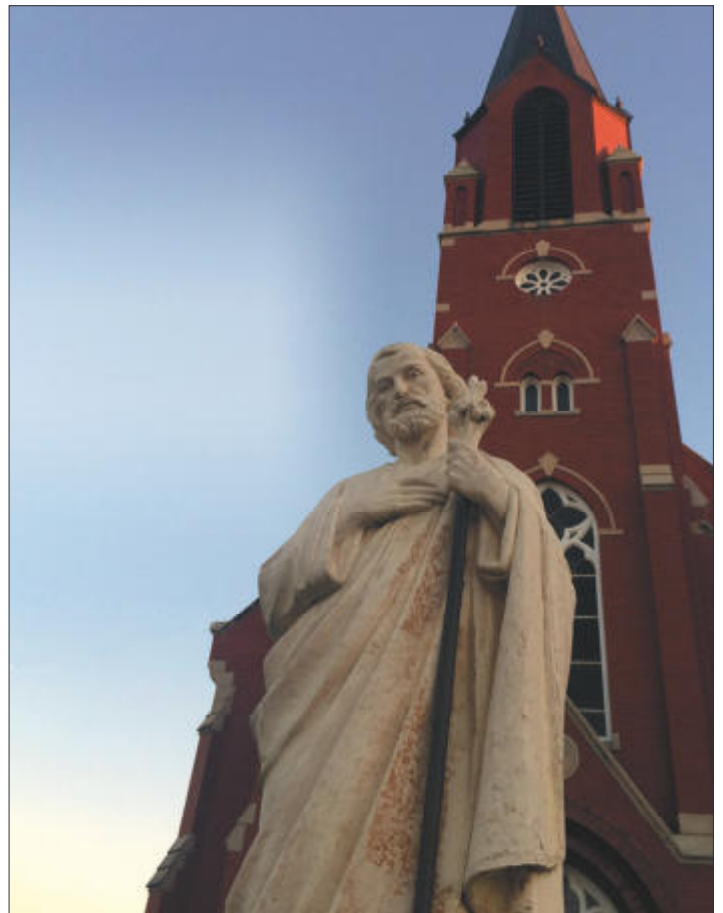

Reflections from Father Daryl

The Magic Castle

Once upon a time a weary traveler was wandering down a dark and scary road. Suddenly there appeared before him a bright and marvelous castle with a welcome sign over the entrance. Knowing he had reached rest and safety at last, the traveler felt glad. Approaching the open gate he saw a strange sight. Other travelers were walking right past the castle as if it wasn't there. He asked a castle resident about this strange behavior and heard this reply: "This is a magic castle. It can be seen only by those who realize and admit they have lost their way. The castle can't appear to persons who pretend to know where they are going, who demand their own way. Your own self honesty made the castle appear to you. Enter for all its riches are now yours."

Toward the end of his ministry, Jesus takes Peter, James, and John, up a high mountain where he was transfigured before them. Jesus would take these three apostles with him to the garden of Gethsemane after the last supper. The apostles would witness Jesus in the fulness of his glory and would see Jesus in his greatest agony. At the scene of the transfiguration, Peter would proclaim that it was good for them to be there. In the garden of Gethsemane, the apostles were not able to stay awake with the Lord for even an hour. As we look at these two moments for these apostles, we can see our own life experiences.

We are the weary traveler who often is wandering down the dark and scary road of life. This road is often of our own making. We seek to live according to our plans rather than the plans God has for us in our lives. When we are following the plan God has for us and seek to do his will in our lives, we will experience the joy of Peter in the presence of Jesus in the fulness of his glory. When we hold on to our own plans, we will not be able to stay awake with our Lord for even one hour. This season of Lent provides the opportunity to look within ourselves and see whose plan we are striving to follow in our lives.

Over this past year, the plans many of us have had for our lives have been altered in many ways. What has our response been to these changes? In the moments we have found ourselves discouraged, we can be assured that Jesus is there before us waiting to show us the better way, his way. Jesus has declared that he is the way, the truth, and the life. Jesus as the way will allow us to see the kingdom of God present in each one of us. His truth will guide us to share in his joy. In him alone do we find the abundant life we seek. Let us not become so entrenched in our own plans that we fail to see the true kingdom to which we belong.
