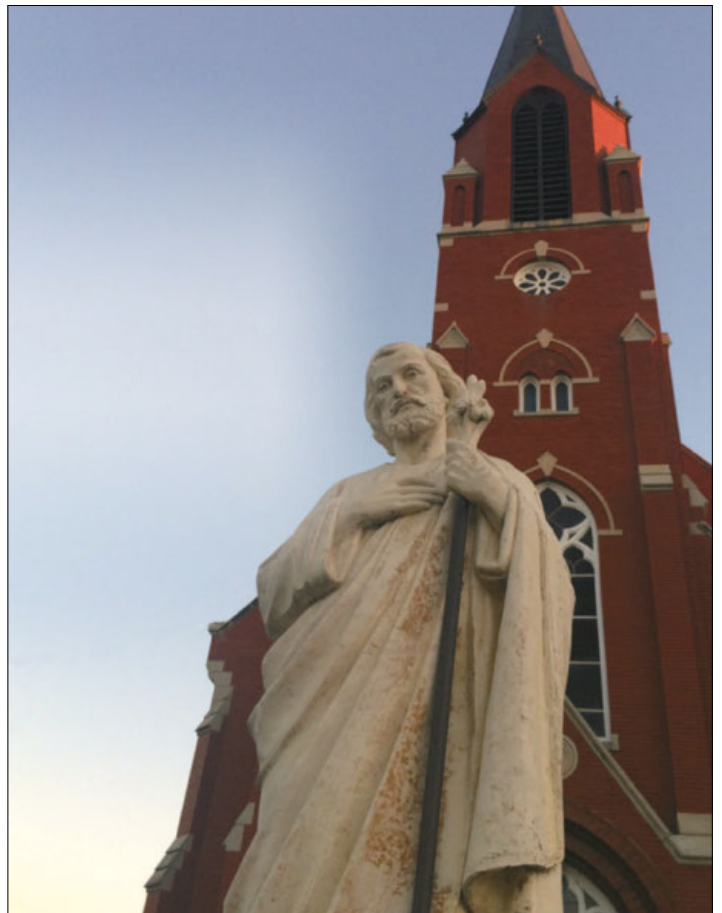

Reflections From Father James Weldon:
