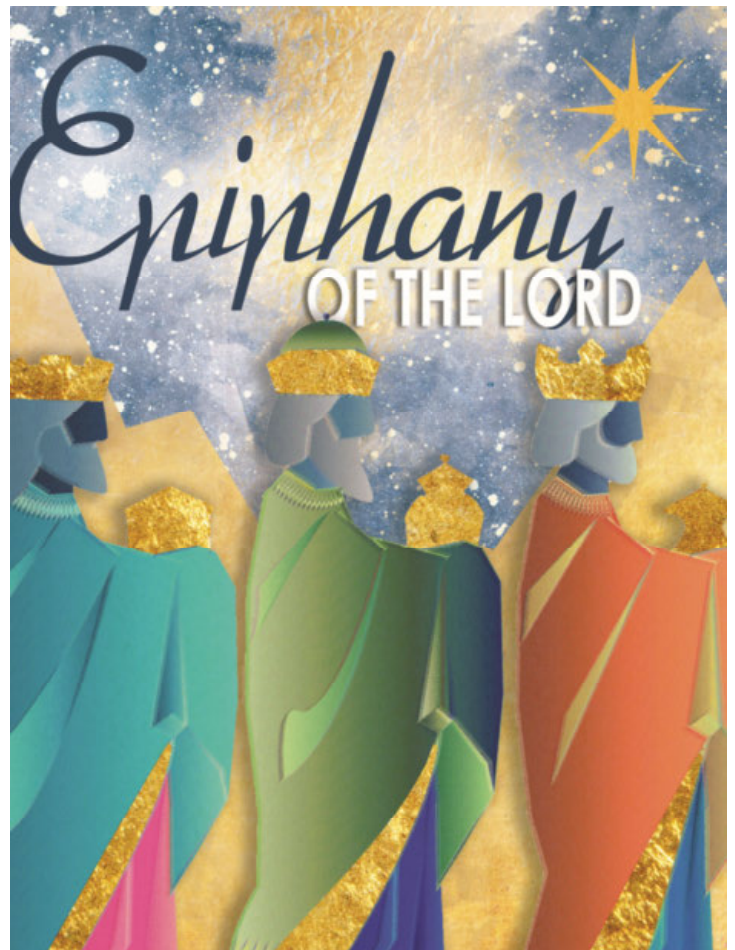

Note from Father Craig Timmerman... You are beloved! Happy New Year! Merry Christmas! Blessed Epiphany! Wow – so much going on this week. Our Christmas season this year is very compacted – Saturday we had the feast of Mary, Mother of God (New Year's Day), and today already we have the Epiphany. We Three Kings.... This is such a beautiful time of Christmas, to remember that Jesus was born as a light. To all those who live in any darkness whatsoever, Jesus is the Light. When God shines His light into our hearts, it changes us. We focus less on what's wrong, and we instead feel lifted up in His Love, Presence even Joy – even in the midst of difficult situations. When God comes, it changes everything. How has your life been changed this year by the Lord? As you begin this new year, how do you want to draw closer to Him? If last year was a struggle for you in faith, what are you going to do different this year to make this year better? The Wise Men came from a long ways away, but they came and found Jesus. 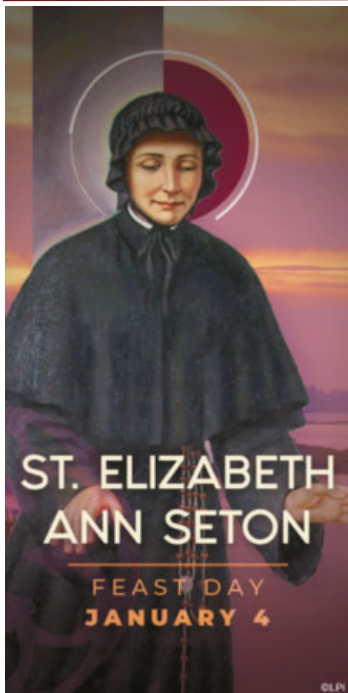

**ST. ELIZABETH ANN SETON | JANUARY 4**

The patron saint of Catholic schools, St. Elizabeth Ann Seton (August 28, 1774 – January 4, 1821) was born in New York City to a prominent family of the Episcopal faith. When she turned 19, she married a wealthy businessman with whom she had five children. He later died of tuberculosis in 1803, leaving her a young widow. After discovering the Catholic faith in Italy, where her husband had died, she returned to New York and converted to Catholicism in 1805.

After several years struggling as a single mother, Elizabeth moved in 1809 to Emmitsburg, Maryland, where she founded the Sisters of Charity of St. Joseph, the first community for religious women established in the United States. She also began St. Joseph's Academy and Free School, which started a chain reaction of Catholic-based education in the United States that continues today.

St. Elizabeth Ann Seton was canonized September 14, 1975 in St. Peter's Square by Pope Paul VI and was the first citizen born in the United States to be given the title of "saint."

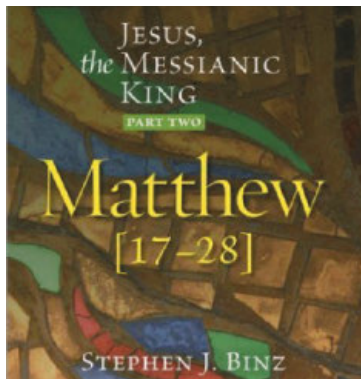

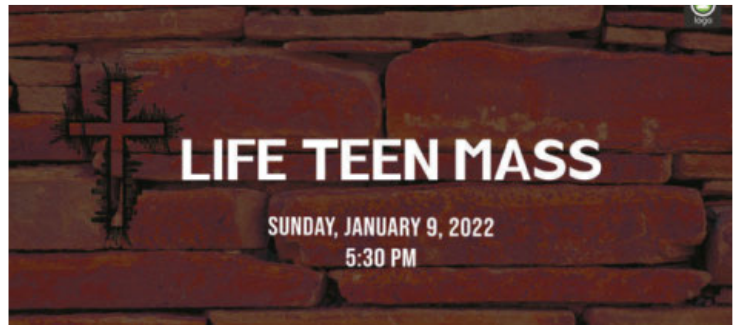

## Home Blessing for the Feast of the Epiphany

It is an ancient tradition to bless our homes at Epiphany with Holy Water and Blessed Chalk. Epiphany means not only the 3 Wise Men, but also the Baptism of the Lord – they used to be celebrated on the same day. Usually the father would write the blessing using the blessed chalk over each and every door going outside: AD 20+C+M+B+22 which stands for "Anno Domini 2022-- Caspar, Melchior, Balthasar" and means "the three Holy Kings, Caspar, Melchior, Balthasar, in the year of Our Lord, 2022" are protecting this house against all evil spirits. The letters C.M.B. also stand for **Christus Mansionem Benedicat = May Christ bless this house**. This tradition of blessing the doorways (with blessed chalk) symbolizes the family's commitment to welcome Christ into their homes on a daily basis throughout the year.

### A FAMILY BLESSING OF THE HOME FOR THE EPIPHANY

All gather at the main entrance to the home.

Head of the family: **God's peace be in this home.** [if desired, he may sprinkle it with Holy Water]

All respond: **And in all who live here.**

All say: **Magi from the East came to Bethlehem to adore the Lord; and opening their treasure chests they presented Him with precious gifts: gold for the great King, incense for the true God, and myrrh in symbol of His burial. Alleluia.**

All then pray the Magnificat, [at this time you may go through the home sprinkling Holy Water, if desired]:

**My soul magnifies the Lord, and my spirit rejoices in God my Savior, for he has regarded the low estate of his handmaiden. For behold, henceforth all generations will call me blessed; for he who is mighty has done great things for me, and holy is his name. And his mercy is on those who fear him from generation to generation. He has shown strength with his arm, he has scattered the proud in the imagination of their hearts, he has put down the mighty from their thrones, and exalted those of low degree; he has filled the hungry with good things, and the rich he has sent empty away. He has helped his servant Israel, in remembrance of his mercy, as he spoke to our fathers, to Abraham and to his posterity forever. Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit. As it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end. Amen.**

Then, all pray the **Our Father** together as a family.

Head of the family: **Let us pray. God, Who on this day revealed your only-begotten Son to all nations by the guidance of a star, grant that we who now know You by faith may finally behold You in Your heavenly majesty; through Christ our Lord. Amen.**

Then, all say: **Be enlightened and shine forth, O Jerusalem, for your light is come; and upon you is risen the glory of the Lord Jesus Christ, born of the Virgin Mary.**

Head of the family: **Nations shall walk in your light, and kings in the splendor of your truth;**

All: **And the glory of the Lord is risen upon you.**

Head of the family: **Bless, O Lord, almighty God, this home so that in it there may be health, chastity, victorious strength, humility, goodness and mildness, obedience to God's laws, and acts of thanks to God the Father, Son, and the Holy Spirit, and may this Blessing remain upon this house, and upon all who dwell in it. Through Christ Our Lord, Amen.**

Meanwhile, he takes the blessed chalk and inscribes on the top of the door frame:

**20 + C + M + B + 22**

All conclude with the **Sign of the Cross**.
