Note from Father Craig Timmerman... You are beloved! I want to express my gratitude for all the cards, gifts and Christmas greetings I received from you. I was honored by the outpouring of your cards. It's taken me until now just to open them all. I will not have time to respond to them individually this year – so please accept this as my thank you card. I am so grateful the Lord has placed me here in these parishes, the Apostles Peter and Paul Area Faith Community. You are truly good people here, and I am honored to be your priest. Please pray that I may always be a good spiritual father to His people here. I pray for you every day that the Lord may bless you, that you draw very close to Him in good times and in bad, and that He will give the greatest gift of His Son, and eternal life in heaven to you and

your families.

This weekend we have the Wedding at Cana. There is a progression to our last 3 Sundays – We celebrated the 3 Magi visiting the baby Jesus which we call Epiphany, then we had The Baptism of the Lord and today the Wedding at Cana. Originally, Epiphany celebrated all 3 of these events in one big celebration! The Eastern Churches (Orthodox, Byzantine, etc.) still do this. These were the 3 great manifestations of Jesus' identity: He is the Beloved Son of God. In the wise men Jesus is revealed to all nations, even the magi from a far country; in the Baptism the Father speaks from heaven to testify that this is His Beloved Son and we should listen to Him; at the Wedding at Cana He shows He is the Son of God by working His first miracle, and his disciples begin to believe that He is the Messiah. These things are written down because they really happened, and the Gospel writers (evangelists) write them down so that we can also believe that Jesus is the Son of God, made flesh in our humanity. Today at the wedding feast of Cana, God comes down and 'marries' His people (Isaiah, our first reading). He proclaims in His Blood Covenant that He will always be our God, a Bridegroom to the Church, His Bride. He is always faithful. Jesus' love renews us every time we go to Him. This love is active in a special way in the Sacrament of marriage, where He gives grace for a husband and wife to be faithful until death. They raise children and bring them into this covenant love of God. There is so much here! Tell God thank you, and worship and pray to Him today – He is Savior of the World! You are beloved!






ST. SEBASTIAN | JANUARY 20

Not much is known about the life of St. Sebastian (256 – 287), except that he was a Roman martyr whose name has been mentioned throughout history since early 350.

We see St. Sebastian many times in art, especially from iconic paintings from Guido Reni, Andrea Mantegna and Hendrick ter Brugghen. Historical scholars now agree that a spiritual story has the beloved saint entering the Roman army because only there could he assist Christian martyrs without arousing suspicion on himself. Eventually he was found out, brought before Emperor Diocletian and delivered to Mauritanian archers to be shot to death. Pierced with arrows, he was left for dead, but managed to survive. He recovered from his wounds but still refused to leave.

One day, St. Sebastian took up a position near where the emperor was to pass. He confronted the emperor, condemning him for his cruelty to Christians. This time the sentence of death was carried out, and St. Sebastian was beaten to death with clubs. Today he is the patron saint of athletes.


