

A MESSAGE FROM FATHER CRAIG

You are beloved! This week we celebrate Catholic Schools Week! I want to take a chance to honor John Ireland Catholic School. John Ireland School is a ministry of our parish of St. Peter in fact, there is no other ministry that touches more families and lives than II. Our parish gladly supports JI in every way! Think of all the families who walk in our doors because they got connected through JI. There are so many students and families, Catholic or not, who experience the Catholic faith in a positive way, through caring teachers, prayer services in Church, fun faith filled programs, adoration in the chapel, priest visits, Sisters' visits, learning how to pray regularly throughout the day, etc. This daily experience of turning to God teaches our students and families such an important truth: God is that close to us every day. I recently was talking to a student who graduated from Jl. I asked how it was going, and this student said that it was harder to stay close to God because God is not a part of the daily schedule in public school. I am so proud of John Ireland!

In the Gospel today Jesus begins the Sermon on the Mount. It says that "when he saw the crowds, he went up the mountain, and after he had sat down, his disciples came to him. And He began to teach them...." Jesus is a teacher. He is THE Teacher! Often, his disciples simply called Him, 'Teacher'. He teaches us truth, real truth, because He is God speaking. In Catholic School, we take this very seriously - our teachers receive their teaching authority from Him! It is a great privilege to teach in a Catholic School, and know you are taking on the authority of Jesus, the Teacher. There is a saying that you've probably heard before that I love. "Let it be known to all who enter here that Jesus Christ is the reason for this school, the unseen but ever-present teacher in all its classes, the model of its faculty, and the inspiration for its students." That is the reason John Ireland exists, because Jesus is the greatest teacher that ever lived, and He is here.

Can I ask you a favor this week? Please stop and thank our principal, our teachers, our paras, our secretaries and business manager, our custodians, our lunch managers and assistants, our tutors, our school nurse, our priest, not to mention all our volunteers who fill the classrooms daily with Christ! I am so proud of our school! There are so many great things going on!

Once again, our students numbers are up! Our family participation is excellent! Our fundraisers are up as well! We have been able to increase funding to support higher salaries and bonuses for our staff! Our students are head and shoulders above the state average, especially after a couple years of CoVid. We had teachers come back to keep teaching, just to make sure our students have good teachers. We have teachers adding more time and energy and going outside the box to provide the best possible! We have had college students and graduates step up to take part-time positions to fill in the gaps. Above all our principal, Colleen Wenner, is stepping into the middle school classroom to teach again, to make sure our students have the best education we can provide! I am so grateful for them and all of you who have stepped in to help out, even if for a few hours when we needed a fillin. God bless you for your generosity. God will grant you His reward, truly.

The point is this - it is Christ who is there, teaching our students at JI, and there is no more important education they can receive than this. So thank you, thank you, thank you! And if you or someone you know could help us in the classroom this semester - let us know! There is no greater joy than to bring Christ to people, right here in the daily life of our students and families. You are beloved!




