

A MESSAGE FROM **FATHER CRAIG**

You are beloved! There are a few big dates coming up! Of course, today is the Superbowl and we have the 'Soup-er Bowl'! Thank you for coming to support our youth. This is such a great opportunity to enjoy, build our Church family together, and support a good local cause. Thank the kids and especially their adult small group leaders

who work with them to make the soup. Then we have Valentine's Day. Read the story of St. Valentine! He is a great saint. Then, tell your family you love them. This week we also have our clergy days - for all priests to gather with our Bishop. Therefore there will not be Mass Tuesday or Wednesday this week. Then Thursday and Friday is a seminary visit - so pray for young men to answer the call to the priesthood! God is calling, but it's sometimes hard to hear Him today. Lastly, just 10 days away, Feb. 22, is Ash Wednesday! Start praying about your Lent. Not so much what to give up, but more how does God want you to grow this Lent? When I am able to hear Jesus' voice more clearly, that helps everything. When I get so busy, I am often listening to all the other voices in my life and can't tell which is God and which is not. I think this is the same for us all. I encourage you to find a time for a retreat. Lent is a great time! Look up the local retreat centers, and see what is available. And remember always, You are beloved!






VOLUNTEERS NEEDED
