

A MESSAGE FROM FATHER CRAIG

You are beloved! This Tuesday, March 28th at 7 PM is our Night of Mercy and Restoration! Every year we have had a night of Mercy, but this year we are adding 'and Restoration'. Not only will we have beautiful adoration, a brief talk to start, wonderful music again by Megan Avila, and confessions

available with 5 Priests!, but this year, we are adding Prayer Teams as well. There will be a few different 'teams' of men and women there offering prayer for anyone who wants someone to pray with you. They will be in the back of the Church area. You simply approach them, let them know what you want them to pray for and they will pray for you. It could be healing for yourself or someone you know - physical, spiritual or emotional. It could be asking God's help with a situation. Whatever it is, it helps so much to have someone pray with you. These teams are used to praying with people, so I expect it will be a powerful experience for you. So please plan on coming at 7:00pm and staying to the end, for adoration, confession and/or prayer ministry. Can I give you a special encouragement to approach lesus in confession this year, please? Jesus died to forgive our sins. Confession is such a powerful Sacrament to receive that forgiveness. The Church asks us to go at least once a year in Lent, though Mary often has encouraged people to go once a month. Either way, it is an important part of our Catholic faith and the best kept secret on Earth! I can't wait!

Today in our readings we have Lazarus who dies, and then Jesus raises him back to life after 4 days. It is powerful, first of all, because Jesus loves Lazarus deeply. But He still lets Lazarus suffer sickness and die. God loves you even when He allows suffering and death. Because there is something even greater than death -Resurrection! lesus loves us so much. He came to die for us, and then RISE AGAIN! 'I AM the Resurrection and the Life. Whoever believes in me, even if he dies, will live.' St. Paul said in the 2nd reading from Romans, 'If the Spirit dwells in you, the one who raised Jesus from the dead will give life to your mortal bodies also.' He is very clear, our mortal bodies will be raised back to life, not only our spirits. Jesus tells Martha to believe this. They remove the stone. He calls Lazarus back to life. Jesus is not just teaching the resurrection of the dead, but showing the resurrection by real life experience. He prepares them for His own resurrection, which is not only a 'coming back to life', but rising to a NEW life. His human body and soul become immortal, and shine with the glory of God. Jesus promises that we will rise! So no matter what mourning or suffering we go through, never lose faith. Because we will rise again! You are beloved!




REMBER US IN YOUR WILL

RAISE RIGHT (SCRIP) The scrip program has formally changed its name to Raise Right. It is the same program, and you can continue to purchase online during school break.


ADORATION ON HOLY THURSDAY
