

A MESSAGE FROM FATHER CRAIG

You are beloved! Today we celebrate the Ascension of the Lord, when Jesus ascends body and soul to heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. This actually happened 40 days after Easter (Ascension Thursday). Then, 10 days later the Apostles received the Holy Spirit at Pentecost and the Church was born in power! These 9 days

between the Ascension and Pentecost we pray the 'Novena to the Holy Spirit' - you can easily do a search and begin praying a novena on Monday. Any novena to the Holy Spirit is just fine. This is the origin of the practice of praying a 9 day novena!

At Sunday Mass this week we are saying thank you and goodbye to 2 employees: Kate Aguilar and Colleen Wenner. Kate served one year as the Youth Faith Formation Director. I am so grateful how she stepped forward last summer, nudged by the Holy Spirit, to do this on top of her teaching responsibilities at Gustavus. Colleen Wenner has been with us longer than almost anyone else - 27 years! We are so grateful to her. She began teaching right out of college and then became our principal 10 years ago. She has been a truly wonderful leader for our school in Catholic faith and in strong educational identity. We cannot properly express our gratitude to her for all she has done for us. "How shall I repay the Lord for all the good He has done for me? I shall raise the cup of salvation and call upon the name of the Lord." (Psalm 116). Thank you, Colleen!

As we celebrate the Ascension today, I invite you to reflect on the way our lives are actually rooted in heaven, not on earth. Jesus is in heaven. At Easter He was raised to a new existence, a new way of living in relationship with the Father. We received that same grace at our Baptism, and we live with 'one foot in heaven' already! Our Head, the One we love above all else, is there, Jesus. Our hearts are there already in many ways. We live for heaven while living our life on earth. This marks all our decisions, what we love, what we do or don't do, what we teach our children, what we hold as important and secondary. I just finished directing a retreat for the Handmaids of the Heart of Jesus sisters (I do one each year). Just like the men I directed 2 weeks ago, it was an experience of the real relationship we have with Our Father, Jesus, the Holy Spirit, and Mary and all of heaven! This is our identity - to be beloved children of Our Father.

Corpus Christi EUCHARISTIC PROCESSION Led by Bishop Chad Zielinski



The procession, led by Bishop Zielinski, will begin from the Diocesan Pastoral Center, 1421 6th Street North (overlooking the New Ulm Medical Center). There will be Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament offered at the Pastoral Center chapel beginning at 3 p.m.
