## Fr. Jerome's Message ...

### Jesus is Risen, Alleluia!!!

Holy Week was filled with tragedies and catastrophic events. For most of the critiques of Jesus, Good Friday was the end. They mobilized the innocent crowd to turn against Jesus whom they considered a great prophet. They made mockery of truth. The war was exploding nailing Jesus to the cross. For them, Good Friday was the end, but for the believers, it was the beginning of a new chapter of hope and life.

Three people appear in the Easter Gospel: Mary of Magdala, Peter and the disciple whom Jesus loved, generally regarded as John. Mary of Magdala comforted Mary, the mother of Jesus, as he was executed; John, to whom Jesus had entrusted his mother as the mother of all; and Peter were there. Peter was there somewhere half the way, but needed time to himself to overcome his personal grief of denial. He did join Jesus, at least sometime, on the Way.

The three prominent figures who accompanied Jesus to Calvary, are seen at the Resurrection event. Mary of Magdala, who went to the tomb early in the morning, witnessed the empty tomb but met the Risen Jesus in the garden. It was the Risen Jesus who identified Mary of Magdala. Peter, who was more passionate than ever, and John, the beloved disciple, met at the empty tomb. They saw and believed. Jesus reconnects to his disciples. His relationship is just not forgotten, everyone is in his memory and close to his heart.

Holy Thursday – our Lord's Supper – the Eucharistic Feast - brought us together in Jesus' Body and Blood. Good Friday – the Passion of the Lord - brought redemption to humanity. Easter Sunday – our Risen Lord brought us Hope and New Life. He dies no more, and He lives forever.

**Thought of the Week:** "True love causes pain. Jesus, in order to give us the proof of His love, died on the cross. A mother, in order to give birth to her baby, has to suffer. If you really love one another, you will not be able to avoid making sacrifices." (Mother Teresa)

### ENCYCLICAL LETTER "FRATELLI TUTTI" OF THE HOLY FATHER FRANCIS ON FRATERNITY AND SOCIAL FRIENDSHIP (Oct 03, 2020)

5. Issues of human fraternity and social friendship have always been a concern of mine. In recent years, I have spoken of them repeatedly and in different settings. In this Encyclical, I have sought to bring together many of those statements and to situate them in a broader context of reflection. In the preparation of Laudato Si', I had a source of inspiration in my brother Bartholomew, the Orthodox Patriarch, who has spoken forcefully of our need to care for creation. In this case, I have felt particularly encouraged by the Grand Imam Ahmad Al-Tayyeb, with whom I met in Abu Dhabi, where we declared that "God has created all human beings equal in rights, duties and dignity, and has called them to live together as brothers and sisters". [5] This was no mere diplomatic gesture, but a reflection born of dialogue and common commitment. The present Encyclical takes up and develops some of the great themes raised in the Document that we both signed. I have also incorporated, along with my own thoughts, a number of letters, documents and considerations that I have received from many individuals and groups throughout the world. 


