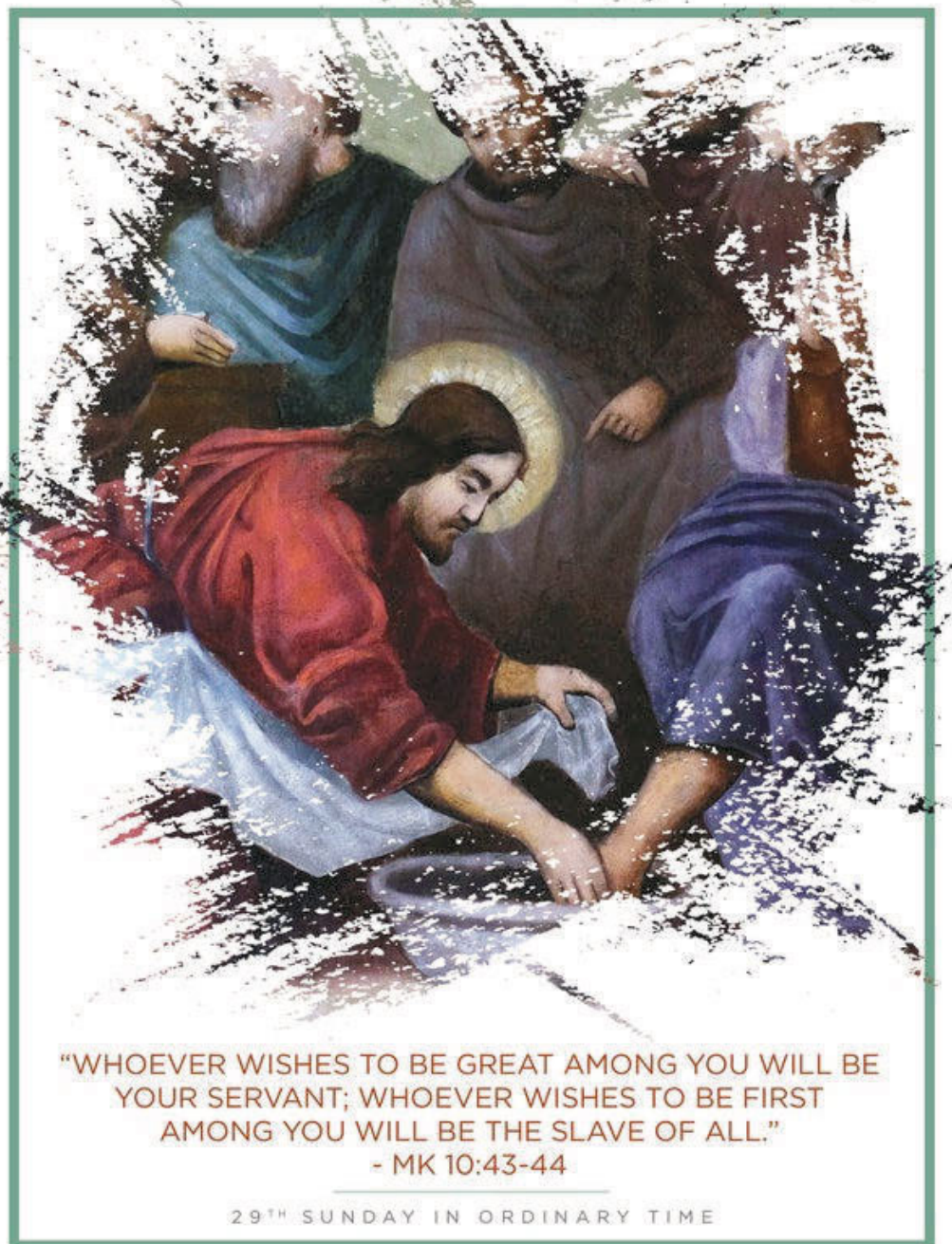

Father Jerome's Message ... Honor of Serving (Mark 10:35-45)

It is hard to swim against the current. To stand alone in the crowd is a challenge. Two disciples sought places of honor in the Kingdom of Jesus. From the worldly point of view, there was nothing unusual in doing so. It showed how much the disciples were rooted in worldly ways. They understood it as a failure to present themselves as vulnerable and powerless. They wanted positions of power, status, recognition and to be served.

Jesus wants to set a different standard for his disciples than that of his contemporaries. His kingdom is not about thrones and crowns or any dominating structure. To teach them the nature of the kingdom, Jesus presented himself to be a subject of suffering and humiliation, a man who serves, and finally as the one giving up his life for the sake of others. The places of honor in his kingdom are obtained by self-emptying, serving and giving one's life. True greatness comes through humble service.

34.
