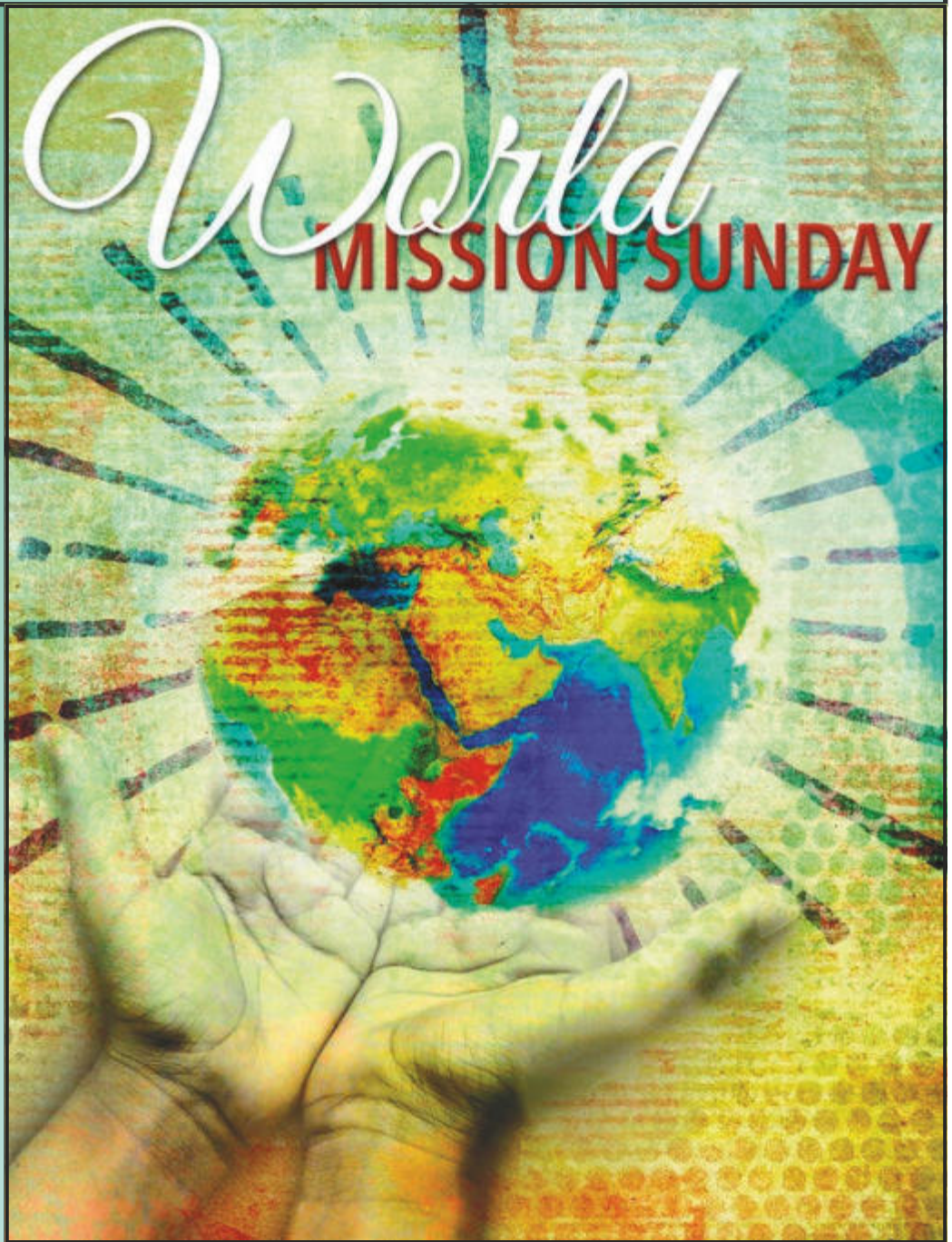

#### PANDEMICS AND OTHER CALAMITIES IN HISTORY

35.
