Remembering Sister Alicita

Sister Pat (Alicita) Sheridan, FSPA, 94, died Friday, November 19, 2021 at Villa St. Joseph, in La Crosse, Wisconsin. Sister Alicita was a teacher at DePadua high school. Her love for music and keen musical ability



served as the basis for much of her ministry.

She began as an elementary school music teacher in 1949. After earning a bachelor's degree in music education from Viterbo College, La Crosse, Sister Alicita taught high school music for 21 years in Ashland (DePadua) and La Crosse (Aquinas) in Wisconsin and Carroll (Kuemper) in Iowa.

Alumni of DePadua from the 1950's and 1960's fondly remember Sister Alicita's joy in music. One DePadua alumnus wrote, "She was the only high school teacher for band, orchestra, and all choirs... Her knowledge and expertise in teaching us music was inspirational."

Sister Alicita was laid to rest at a family plot at St. Joseph Cemetery in Kendall, Wisconsin. Please see Schumacher-Kish Funeral and Cremation Services - La Crosse for full obituary.

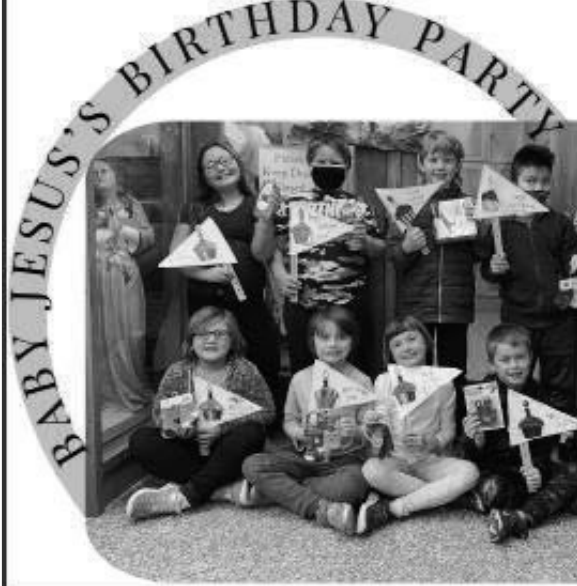
