

Father Jerome's Message ... Temptations (Luke 4:1-13)

The First Sunday of Lent focuses on the Lenten Mission: The First Precept of the Church – "You shall attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of obligation and rest from servile labor."

What are those three temptations before Jesus as he was fully prepared to start his mission? All three temptations of Jesus are predicated on conditional clauses: "If you are the Son of God" (temptations 1 & 3), "provided you worship me" (temptation 2). It is easy for Jesus to resist such temptations, because, in his heart, there is no "if" clause with regards to God.

Jesus overcomes the temptations and sin, not only on this occasion but all the time because His heart is in the right place. What a great lesson we can learn at the beginning of Lent, to put our heart in the right place. Therefore, the First Precept of the Church just helps us to fulfill this obligation. Surprisingly, we are lucky to have Sunday Masses in and around our town, not just one Mass, there are four Masses. It is not the question of having no Masses but having us go to participate. Look at the advantages of attending Mass on Sundays – making a believing community; possibilities of getting more friends; building up new relationships; listening to the Word of God and participating in the Eucharist; time to open up to God...

Resist a temptation to skip Sunday Mass, make the devil frustrated by attending Sunday Mass. You can do this if your heart is in the right place!

Thought of the Week: "Show me your hands. Do they have scars from giving? Show me your feet. Are they wounded in service? Show me your heart. Have you left a place for divine love"." (Fulton Sheen)

Question of the Week: Where is your heart?

Evangelii Gaudium (The Joy of the Gospel) is a 2013 apostolic exhortation by Pope Francis "On the proclamation of the Gospel in today's world."
