Father Jerome’s Message ...

“This is my chosen Son; listen to him” (Luke 9:28b-36)

Second Sunday of Lent, focuses on our Lenten Mission: The Second Precept of the Church –
“You shall confess your sins at least once a year.”

Before the Passion, Jesus leads the prominent disciples – Peter, John and James, to Mount Tabor to pray. The mountain top is symbolically and literally closer to God. The Transfiguration opens up a new vitality, puts new dynamism and orients us to the future with new hope.

Our Lenten Mission theme invites us to ponder over the Sacrament of Reconciliation/Confession. It is no doubt a transfiguration experience. It is revealing who you are before God; before others and before yourself. No doubt, sin is a part of our nature, but Confession is an opportunity to overcome it. It is an invitation to transform our natural world and be open to God’s intervention. God is a merciful judge who wants His children to enjoy His mind and will. Confession brings peace; it brings nearness to God; it supplies courage and vigor; it brings a lot of sense to our unchecked life; it helps us to reform our lives and puts us on the right track. Without Confession, we feel terrible, fearful, anxious, doubtful, unfaithful, broken, empty, passive, lifeless... Pope Francis invites us, “Let us not close our hearts, let us not lose confidence, let us never give up: there are no situations which God cannot change, there is no sin which he cannot forgive if only we open ourselves to Him.”

Third Sunday of Lent	You shall receive the Sacrament of Eucharist at least during the Easter season (CCC 1389; 2042).
Fourth Sunday of Lent	You shall observe the days of fasting and abstinence established by the Church (CCC 22043; 2177).
Fifth Sunday of Lent	You shall help to provide for the needs of the Church (CCC 1351; 1387; 1438; 2043).

It is a visual reminder of our Lenten journey and we sincerely appreciate the generosity and stewardship of Karen, Dan and Kevin.
- Maintenance Memo:** Members of the maintenance team would like to remind everyone to be extremely cautious when grounds care equipment is in use: snowblowers, snowplows or lawn mowers around Our Lady of the Lake Church. Drivers of the equipment are focused intently on their work and do not have a clear view of pedestrians. **For your safety, please DO NOT WALK BEHIND EQUIPMENT WHEN IN USE!**
- Reduce, Reuse, Recycle:** Our Lady of the Lake has numerous new and slightly used 4' tube fluorescent light bulbs to **GIVE AWAY** to good homes. The fluorescent bulbs were used in the social hall which is being updated with new LED lights. The LED lights will be a considerable savings in energy usage. The florescent bulbs for **GIVE AWAY** are T8, that is, one inch in diameter, and 4100K - cool white light. The cool white light is suitable for workspaces where bright lighting is essential. Please contact the Pastoral Center office, 715-682-7620, to claim one or several of the fluorescent bulbs.
