It's looking a lot like Christmas, all around the school!

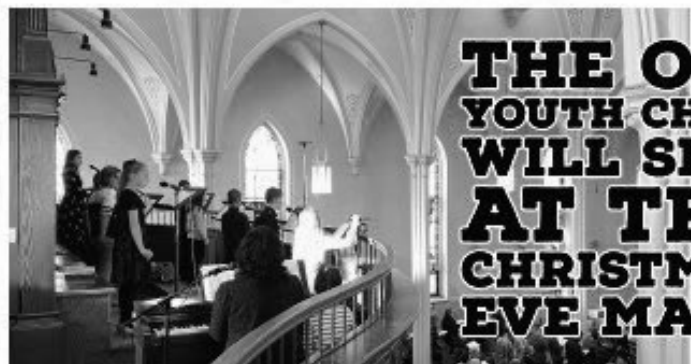
