

## Father Jerome's Message...God's commandments (Matthew 5:17-37)

Jesus continues the sermon on the mount. He invites us to reflect on something very fundamental to everyone. He gives no excuse, but strict adherence. It is God's will and not human will. Two hundred years prior to Jesus Ben Sira taught his Jewish readers that God did not give humanity free will in order to give us license to do what we want, but to give us freedom to choose between right and wrong, with the realization that salvation comes to those who choose to keep God's commands.

There is no excuse or compromise to God's commandments, to follow or not to follow or to occasionally follow some of them. The commandments are revered and observed throughout life. Jesus places before us what is pleasing to God - the offering made with contrite heart and reflected in one's daily life. Reconciliation is at the heart of Jesus' teaching today. Where do you stand listening to today's gospel?

#### I. Some challenges of today's world

No to an economy of exclusion

54. In this context, some people continue to defend trickle-down theories which assume that economic growth, encouraged by a free market, will inevitably succeed in bringing about greater justice and inclusiveness in the world. This opinion, which has never been confirmed by the facts, expresses a crude and naïve trust in the goodness of those wielding economic power and in the sacralized workings of the prevailing economic system. Meanwhile, the excluded are still waiting. To sustain a lifestyle which excludes others, or to sustain enthusiasm for that selfish ideal, a globalization of indifference has developed. Almost without being aware of it, we end up being incapable of feeling compassion at the outcry of the poor, weeping for other people's pain, and feeling a need to help them, as though all this were someone else's responsibility and not our own. The culture of prosperity deadens us; we are thrilled if the market offers us something new to purchase. In the meantime all those lives stunted for lack of opportunity seem a mere spectacle; they fail to move us.

## How We Make a Difference Together...

- Lent: Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, February 22nd. Ash Wednesday is a day of fasting and abstinence. As we look forward to this holy season of prayer, fasting and almsgiving, please keep in mind the regulations for fasting and abstinence from the Unites States Conference of Catholic Bishops:
  - 1. Everyone 14 years of age or over is bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, all Fridays of Lent, and on Good
  - 2. Everyone between 18 and 59 years of age is bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, except those who may be excused; those who are physically or mentally ill, those who suffer from chronic illnesses, people whose ability to do necessary work would be negatively affected, and women who are pregnant or nursing.
  - 3. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal.
- Saint Paschal Baylon Adoration Chapel: We are grateful for the many volunteers who dedicate time each week in prayerful adoration of the Real Presence of our Lord. We appreciate coordinator, Teresa Ochsenbauer, for her work in scheduling volunteers and managing chapel hours. While it is true that we can pray to God anywhere and that He is always with us, it is especially powerful to adore Jesus in the Eucharist. In the words of Mother Theresa of Calcutta, "The time you spend with Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament is the best time that you will spend on earth. 

Every year Lent gives each of us the opportunity to grow closer to Christ in some intentional way. The three main pillars of Lent are Prayer, Fasting and Almsgiving. As Catholics, we are called to participate in all these areas, cultivating our spiritual life, so we emulate Christ. This coming Lent, we hope you join us to grow in PRAYER through community, knowledge, and understanding. Every Sunday during Lent we will dive deeper into the greatest gift God Our Father gave us, His son Jesus Christ. We receive this gift every Mass through the Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of Our Savior in the Eucharist. This gift is not a symbol as some Christians understand nor are we entitled to this free gift as some Catholic's feel. The Eucharist is the source and summit of Christian living.
