Father Jerome's Message...First Sunday of Lent

Presence - Mystery of the Eucharist: First Session - God is with Us

During the five weeks of Lent, deacons of our cluster parishes will facilitate discussions in our faith community to grow deeper into the mystery of the Eucharist after the 9:00 am Mass. What a better opportunity than this during the Eucharistic Year! Here is the overview of the first session – God is with Us (from the Leader's Guide).

You've probably heard some variation of the statement that the Bible is God's love letter to us. The story of salvation is one long romance. It's the story of the God who is Love drawing near to his people and seeking them out as they stray time and again. Finally, God himself came down from Heaven to make a way for us to be united to him. As Vatican II puts it: "Through this revelation, therefore, the invisible God out of the abundance of His love speaks to men as friends and lives among them so that He may invite and take them into fellowship with himself (*Dei Verbum*, 2). This is a beautiful description of the kind of intimacy God desires to have with each of us, and the Church desires that modern men and women come to know this amazing love of God. In this session, we will see that God wants to unite us to himself, to pour his love into us, and to receive our love. He wants this so much that he humbles himself to be truly and completely present to us under the appearances of bread and wine. This the most perfect expression of God's love for us, and when we receive the Eucharist it is the most perfect expression of our love for him. He allows us to receive his Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity in this sacrament so that he can draw us into total communion and intimacy with himself. . . .



56. While the earnings of a minority are growing exponentially, so too is the gap separating the majority from the prosperity enjoyed by those happy few. This imbalance is the result of ideologies which defend the absolute autonomy of the marketplace and financial speculation. Consequently, they reject the right of states, charged with vigilance for the common good, to exercise any form of control. A new tyranny is thus born, invisible and often virtual, which unilaterally and relentlessly imposes its own laws and rules. Debt and the accumulation of interest also make it difficult for countries to realize the potential of their own economies and keep citizens from enjoying their real purchasing power. To all this we can add widespread corruption and self-serving tax evasion, which have taken on worldwide dimensions. The thirst for power and possessions knows no limits. In this system, which tends to devour everything which stands in the way of increased profits, whatever is fragile, like the environment, is defenseless before the interests of a deified market, which become the only rule.




