#### Father Jerome's Message...Second Sunday of Lent

#### Presence - Mystery of the Eucharist: Session 2 – The Story of the Eucharist

During the five weeks of Lent, deacons of our cluster parishes will facilitate discussions in our faith community to grow deeper into the mystery of the Eucharist after the 9:00 am Mass. What a better opportunity than this during the Eucharistic Year! **Here is the overview of the Session 2** (*from the Leader's Guide*).

In the first session, we looked at the profound truth of God's love for us. He is the God who was present with his people throughout the Old Testament, and he is the God who is present with us now – Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity - in the Eucharist. In this session, we will see how the whole story of salvation history is a single narrative leading up to the climatic events of the Paschal mystery. Throughout the Old Testament, God had been preparing his people for the Eucharist through many prefigurations. Likewise, Jesus prepared his followers for the gift of the Eucharist throughout his public ministry. Through the miracles of changing water into wine and multiplying loaves of bread, Jesus was preparing for the greater miracle of changing bread and wine into his own Body and Blood. He taught his disciples what this meant in the Bread of Life discourse in John 6 and at the institution of the Eucharist at the Last Supper. When he told his Apostles to "do this in remembrance of me" (Luke 22:19), he instituted the priesthood and gave the instruction to them and their successors to celebrate this new Passover as a memorial – a way of making his one-time sacrifice present and efficacious for all ages....With great desire and faith, we pray: "Lord, give us this bread always" (John 6:34).


#### CHAPTER TWO: AMID THE CRISIS OF COMMUNAL COMMITMENT

#### I. Some challenges of today's world

No to a financial system which rules rather than serves

57. Behind this attitude lurks a rejection of ethics and a rejection of God. Ethics has come to be viewed with a certain scornful derision. It is seen as counterproductive, too human, because it makes money and power relative. It is felt to be a threat since it condemns the manipulation and debasement of the person. In effect, ethics leads to a God who calls for a committed response which is outside the categories of the marketplace. When these latter are absolutized, God can only be seen as uncontrollable, unmanageable, even dangerous, since he calls human beings to their full realization and to freedom from all forms of enslavement. Ethics – a non-ideological ethics – would make it possible to bring about balance and a more humane social order. With this in mind, I encourage financial experts and political leaders to ponder the words of one of the sages of antiquity: "Not to share one's wealth with the poor is to steal from them and to take away their livelihood. It is not our own goods which we hold, but theirs".[55]






