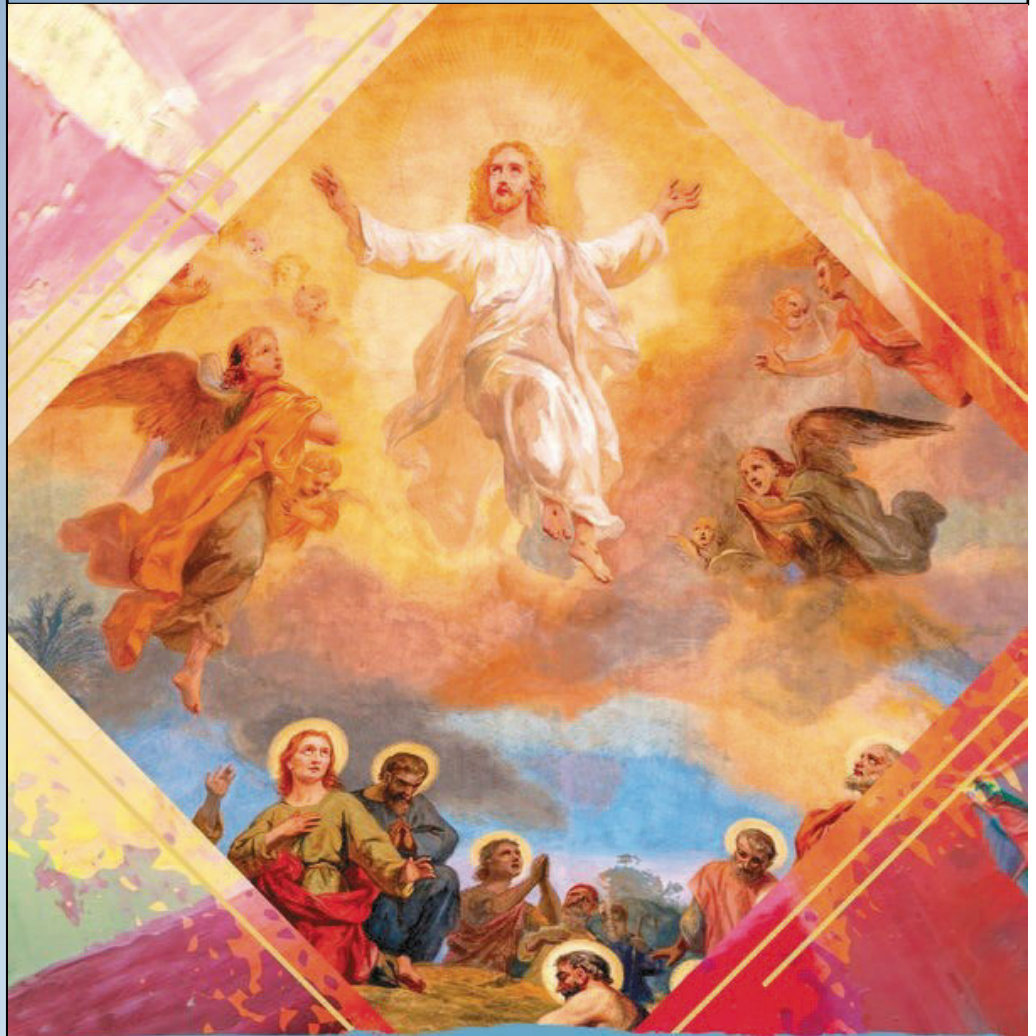

Father Jerome's Message: Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord (Matthew 28:16-20)

St. Rita of Cascia
Religious
Feast Day: May 22

Rita was born in 1381 in the town of Roccaporena in Umbria. She lived with a brutal husband and had two sons. After the violent murder of her husband, she urged forgiveness in contrast to the customary vendetta of her day. Becoming an Augustinian nun she spent some forty years in prayer, contemplation, and service to the sick and poor. Toward the end of her life, she received a wound from a thorn from the crown of thorns. She died in 1457. She is the patron saint of those in desperate situations.

- The Ascension of the Lord:** Today we celebrate the Ascension of the Lord. The Feast of the Ascension commemorates Jesus' ascension into heaven forty days after his resurrection. Thus, Ascension Day falls on the sixth Thursday of Easter. In 2006, the Catholic Bishops of Wisconsin voted to transfer the Solemnity of the Lord's Ascension from Thursday of the 6th Week of Easter to the 7th Sunday of Easter. This was intended to allow a greater number of people to celebrate the feast with due solemnity in the context of the Mass. *"Today our Lord Jesus Christ ascended into Heaven; let our hearts ascend with Him."* - St. Augustine

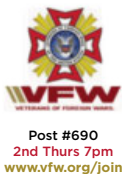
