Happy New Year! With a New Year comes new resolutions – people trying to improve their lives by promising themselves they'll pick up a new habit – be it working out, eating healthier, etc. However, that often comes with new disappointments. The average New Year's Resolution only lasts 36 days!

The key to keeping a resolution is not biting off more than you can chew. Baby steps that gradually get bigger are better than trying to run a marathon immediately (and let me tell you, running a marathon without fully training is awful!). So, remember not to bite off more than you can chew this year, and be compassionate with yourself!

We want to apply this to our prayer as well. 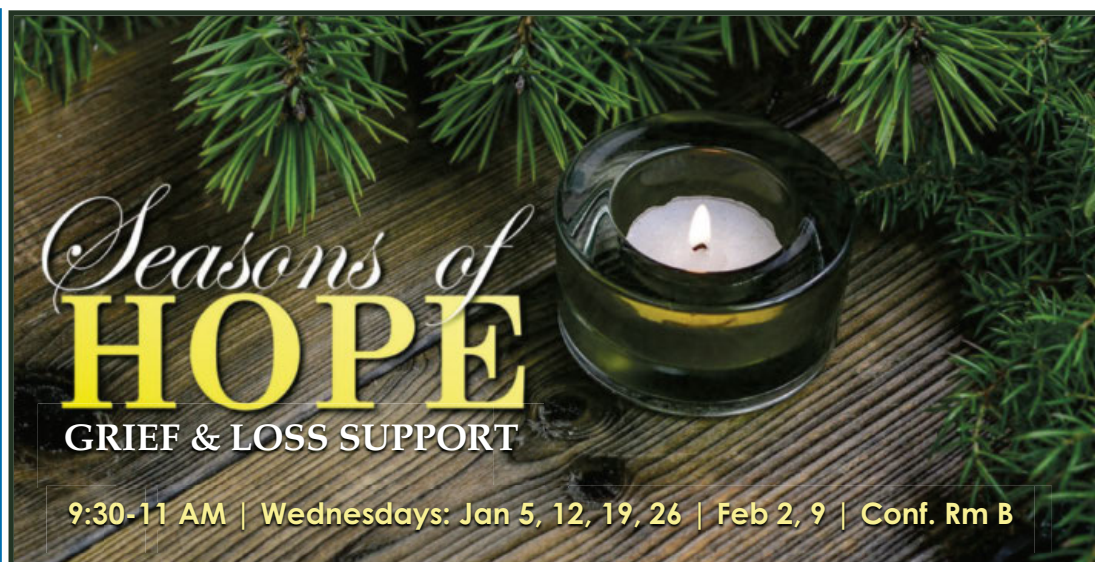

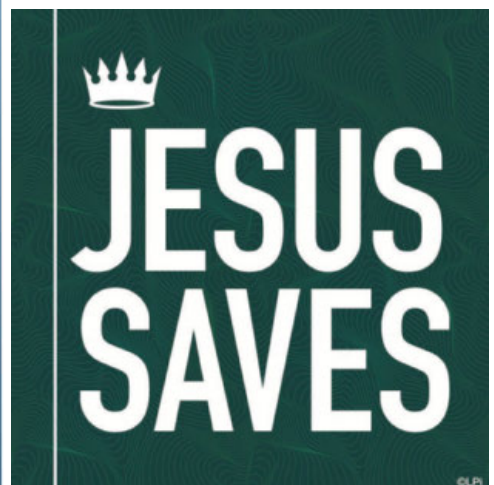

As we celebrate the wise men giving Christ gold, frankincense, and myrrh, may we grow in our givenness and self-offering to Christ. May we steadfastly strive to fulfill the great commands of loving God with all our hearts, minds, and souls and loving our neighbor as ourselves.

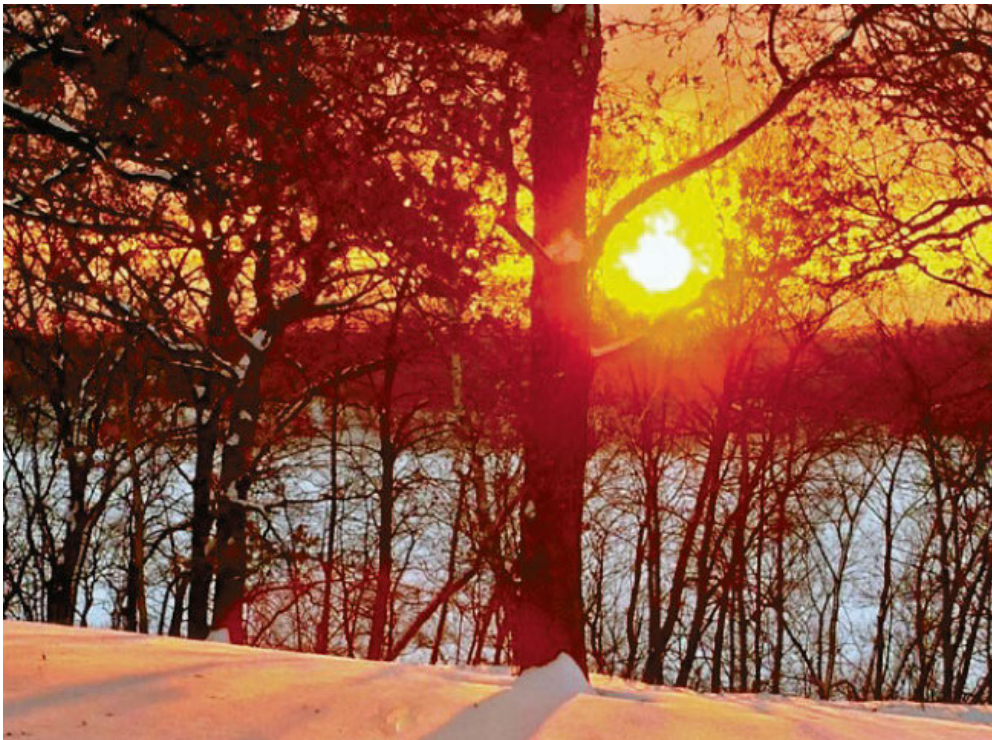
