

Happy New Year! With a New Year comes new resolutions—people trying to improve their lives by promising themselves they'll pick up a new habit—be it working out,

eating healthier, etc. However, that often comes with new disappointments. The average New Year's Resolution only lasts 36 days!

The key to keeping a resolution is not biting off more than you can chew. Baby steps that gradually get bigger are better than trying to run a marathon immediately (and let me tell you, running a marathon without fully training is awful!). 



Epiphany is the universal offer of God's salvation that extends to those still in the




