FAITH FORMATION

Listen To The Father Call You Beloved

As was proclaimed in the Gospel reading, Jesus listened to the voice of the Father say to Him, "You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased" (Luke 3:22). Through the gift of baptism, we become adopted children of God - we too become the Father's beloved.

When we experience difficulties in relationships and have challenging life experiences, we may begin to question the truth of the Father's love. Rather than remembering we are His beloved, we may question if we are lovable, enough, worthy, or good. We may question if we have what it takes, if our presence is wanted, or if our life has meaning or purpose. We may hate ourselves or feel like we need to deal with our distress on our own. Like Jesus, we must *think* like a beloved son and daughter! Our thoughts about ourselves are transformed when we live in the listening of the Father calling us beloved. Our good Father delights in reminding us the truth of His love. By relating our thoughts to Jesus, He can take those lies that may fill our minds and place them in His crown of thorns. We can once again, believe in the truth of our identity as *BELOVED*.




