


FROM OUR ASSOCIATE PASTOR



After four weeks of Advent and a little over two weeks of Christmas, we're back into the Church season of Ordinary Time: instead of purple or white, we're wearing green,

and the readings go back to a general focus. Ordinary Time though is far from "ho-hum" ordinary. In Latin, the name for the season is "Tempus per Annum" or "time through the year;" the word "ordinary" was used in English not to refer to a time that is commonplace, but one that is "ordinal" - that is, counting through the weeks as we progress through the liturgical year.

Our liturgical color for this time isn't just generic either; green isn't used because it seemed like a good average color to use - but rather because of its relation to creation. The color of living and thriving vegetation and the color associated with life and hope, green in the liturgy symbolizes creation, growth, and hope for new life in Christ. Even as we're surrounded by snow, cold, and hibernating vegetation outside, we are called to recall the living hope of God's grace and truth.

The life of a Christian is far from ordinary. Ordinary Time doesn't tell us to live ordinary lives, but instead tells us to live lives of anticipation, counting the days until we meet Our Lord, living out the life of grace and fruitfully sharing it with others. In this time before Lent, how will you joyfully prepare and live a life of expectant hope and growth in grace?


Emergency Collection for those affected by recent tornado damage





FIRST QUARTER 2021-2022 PARISH FINANCIAL REPORT SUMMARY

I am writing to give you an update as to how the parish has performed financially during the first quarter of our current fiscal year. We are doing very well and are ahead of budget in key income areas. Our plate and envelope collections are \$20,596 over budget. We have also exceeded our budget, with the Fall Festival, Capital Campaign and in other operating areas. The school is doing fantastically as we are at capacity in several classes.

The staff continues to manage their budgets responsibly with most departments finishing the quarter under budget with regard to expenses. It is not unusual to have an operating loss at the end of the first quarter. Tuition income does not get recognized in July or August per the Archdiocesan accounting policies, but most of the school expenses are recognized. It is an imbalance that will correct itself over the course of the fiscal year. We continue to be grateful for your generosity and your support of this parish and school.
