Happy New Year!

As we celebrate Catholic Schools Week and flip our calendars to 2022, we have much as a school for which to be grateful.

First, our wonderful families, students, and staff continue to navigate the pandemic, allowing us to continue to educate our students in-person. We have found that many families and students struggled with distance learning, and our goal is to keep the students in school as we move forward.

Also, most of our classrooms are approaching or have reached capacity. Many of our new families who have transferred with older students have commented on how they wished they would have started with us sooner. In fact, several of those families have their children in after-school instruction with Mrs. Amos to become Catholic! It is wonderful to see God's hand at work with evangelization taking place and the school filling up!

The halls are now bustling with 6th, 7th and 8th grade students moving between their classes. We realize that the middle school years are a pivotal time in a child's life, and we are grateful to be able to offer this option to our families. The middle school now has 73 students. We are also very excited that the 8th grade class of 2022 is set to graduate 22 students in early June. This is the largest graduating class yet!

Preschool and Pre-Kindergarten programs continue to fill up each year! The foundation that our Faithful Beginnings program provides for these children sets the stage for them to excel as they continue through the elementary and middle school grades here at St. Peter. As they continue, these students will benefit from our small class sizes, individualized attention, rigorous academics, and faith-filled programs. They will develop individual and critical thinking skills, an appreciation for serving others, and build strong character development which is grounded in good morals and values.

Although Catholic education is invaluable, we realize that not everyone can afford the full cost. Thanks to the many generous parishioners, donors, and friends of St. Peter's School, we are able to help provide a Catholic education to families who desire it for their family. Our school Marathon, Give to the Max Day, and the Golden Gala are the primary ways we help those families. Thank you to all who support us through these efforts!

FAITH FORMATION

Patience and Kindness Towards Yourself

We heard in the second reading that, "Love is patient, love is kind" (1 Corinthians 13:4). This invitation of love includes being patient and kind towards yourself. When there are unhealthy emotional reactions, difficulties in trusting God, and persistent habits of vice, there is a reason why that can go back even to the early years of childhood. For instance, if a child does not form a secure attachment to their parents in the first year of their birth, it can be more difficult for them to have a sense of confidence and trust that God will provide when challenges arise in one's life. The love of God is so gentle. There is no instance in the gospels when a contrite sinner confessed to Jesus and was responded to with condemnation. The voice of self-condemnation, that *you should have known better* or *how could God really forgive you for that again* is not the voice of God. God does not tire in giving mercy; it is only us who tire in asking for it. His gaze is merciful and understanding.

St Therese of Lisieux's older sister saw how holy Therese was and how much she loved God. She wondered if that would ever be possible for her. Therese responded by sharing her confidence in God's love was not from her virtues, gifts, and talents – in fact she considered them nothing. Therese further told her sister, "what pleases him is that he sees me loving my littleness and my poverty, the blind hope that I have in his mercy...That is my only treasure...why would this treasure not be yours?"¹ What Therese kept on the forefront of her mind were not her talents and virtues but God's abundance of mercy for her in her poverty. She loved her littleness and need for God for that is where she met his mercy.

Our weakness is not what keeps God away but is where we meet him, and in that we can rejoice. The love of God for each of us is patient and kind, may we learn to look at ourselves with that love.

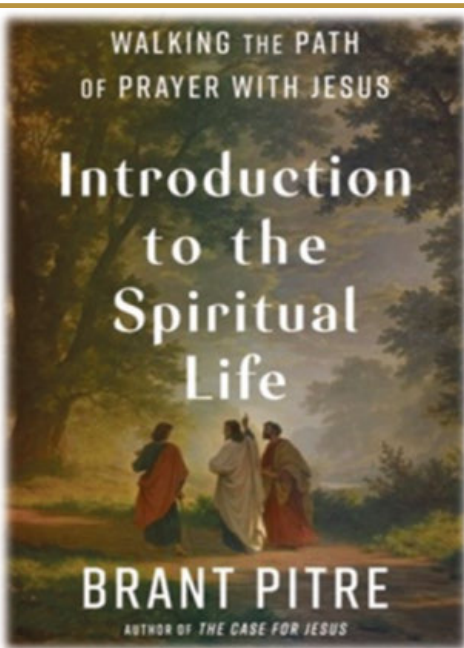

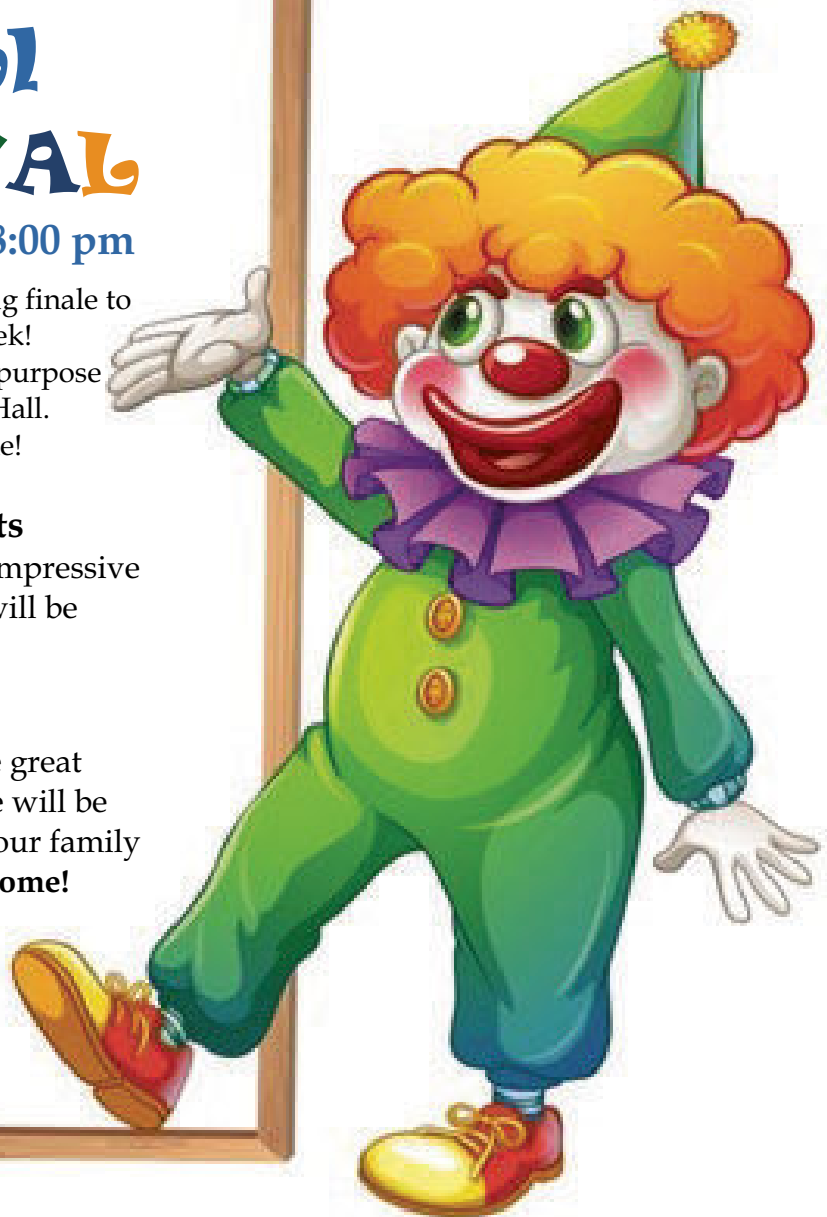
