

Next week when we come to Mass we will be gathering to celebrate Pentecost, the conclusion of our Easter Season. This year we are going all-in with our celebration. There is an option for a Vigil, not unlike Easter. Because it is a vigil it is necessarily extended, a nice way of saying it will be a little longer than our normal Saturday evening anticipated Mass. Please consider yourselves warned. If you do come to this Mass, which I highly recommend, it will be more than the usual 50 minutes or so.

In its 1988 document Paschalis solemnitatis, "On the Preparation and Celebration of the Paschal Feast," the Congregation for Divine Worship urged that "encouragement should be given to the prolonged celebration of Mass in the form of a vigil, whose character is not baptismal as in the Easter Vigil but one of urgent prayer, after the example of the Apostles and disciples, who preserved together in prayer with Mary, the Mother of Jesus, as they awaited the Holy Spirit," (No.107).

I think that this feast is one of the most underrated of the year. At Christmas we recall Jesus being born and walking among us, at Pentecost we remember the Holy Spirit coming upon the Church and Her now being able to fulfill the mission given to us by Christ. Please pray for a fresh outpouring of the Spirit in all our lives, and please consider joining us for the extended vigil, you will not be disappointed.

FIRST READING

Acts 1:1-11 (58B)

In the first book, Theophilus, I dealt with all that Jesus did and taught until the day he was taken up, after giving instructions through the Holy Spirit to the apostles whom he had chosen. He presented himself alive to them by many proofs after he had suffered, appearing to them during forty days and speaking about the kingdom of God. While meeting with them, he enjoined them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for "the promise of the Father about which you have heard me speak; for John baptized with water, but in a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit."

When they had gathered together they asked him, "Lord, are you at this time going to restore the kingdom to Israel?" He answered them, "It is not for you to know the times or seasons that the Father has established by his own authority. But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, throughout Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." When he had said this, as they were looking on, he was lifted up, and a cloud took him from their sight. While they were looking intently at the sky as he was going, suddenly two men dressed in white garments stood beside them. They said, "Men of Galilee, why are you standing there looking at the sky? This Jesus who has been taken up from you into heaven will return in the same way as you have seen him going into heaven."
