This weekend we celebrate the Trinity. One of the greatest gifts we are able to receive in this life is God Himself. As I said this last week at Pentecost, we all received this gift at our baptism. When we allow this gift to flourish, we will be able to see the world in a very different light, and we can do amazing things through living out our vocations.

As I may have mentioned (it is at least in the rough draft of the homily) in his rule for monks, St. Benedict tells his followers that when they examine their lives they are to give credit to God for all the good they do, while taking credit for any sinfulness they commit. This rule is a good reminder for us. If we are truly striving to be faithful servants of God and invite Him into everything we do, this should be our understanding. How great is it to realize that anything that we do well, or any good we accomplish, is God working through us?

Below is a prayer that I would encourage every family to try to say together, maybe before a meal, before bed, or in the morning when starting your day. It can be a powerful prayer that keeps us close to the gift of the Holy Spirit and helps us fulfill everything God has in store for us. This will allow us to more fully live in Trinitarian love. This is the shorter version I use very often. If you choose, you can easily find the full prayer online.

*Come Holy Spirit,
fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love.
Send forth your Spirit and they shall be created.
And You shall renew the face of the earth.*
