Give the Gift of Food this Christmas Season!

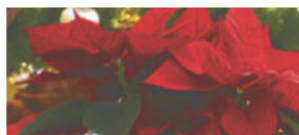

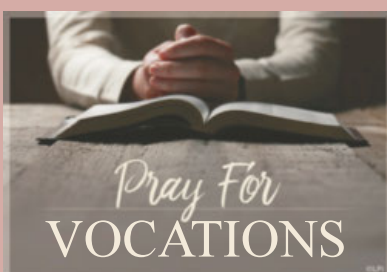
